Laps at Levels Terms and Conditions of entry 2024

Caroline Bay Rock and Hop and the event organiser Hospice South Canterbury Inc along with all committee members will now be referred to as "The event organisers".

When you secure your registration and choose to partake in any of the Levels cruises or to park in the Levels Event precinct, you are agreeing to the contractual "Terms and Conditions" which are clearly posted on our event website carolinebayrockandhop.co.nz/even-more

- You confirm all information provided is correct and true,
- You understand Event Photographers may take a photo that includes you or your vehicle.
 These photos may be used in Social Media and Marketing at the discretion of the Event Organisers.

You Must

- Obtain a vehicle pass sticker at the Event Registration area upon entry and display this on the front windscreen of your car. This pass is only valid if it is legible and it is not mutilated, altered or obscured in any way.
- Obey all volunteers and only park in the allocated areas.
- Not exceed the speed limit of 10kph when within the parking and entrance area.
- Put your rubbish in a bin onsite or take it away with you. Stall holder

The event organisers reserve the right to refuse or revoke entry for irresponsible/unsafe behaviour at their discretion. The event organisers will take no responsibility for any costs incurred by this action.

Rules regarding the participation in Laps at Levels cruises.

- Security of vehicles is the owner's responsibility.
- Your vehicle must have a current WOF and Rego
- All passengers in your vehicle must be wearing a seatbelt. The exception is if your vehicle is pre 1959 and does not have seatbelts. If not, you need to enter the Pre 1959 section of the event.
- You must attend the pre cruise safety briefing and sign the indemnity form provided
- Vehicles will be stagger started, please pay attention when it is your turn
- All vehicles must follow the pace car which will start slower and speed up after the first two laps. There are 4 laps for the pre 1959 entrants and 6 for each other timeslot.
- The safety car cannot be passed at any stage.
- There is to be no passing anywhere except the back straight of the track.
- When passing you need to flash your headlights to let the vehicle in front know that you are coming
- Vehicles can only go 2 wide on the back straight
- If you have registered in the wrong section the event organisers reserve the right to change your cruise time.
- If there is a breakdown on the track all people in that vehicle must stay in the car until told by the safety crew they can exit the vehicle
- If there is a breakdown all vehicles will be moved to the side of the track until it is safe to re enter
- Marshalls must be obeyed at all times
- Any passing on the wrong part of the track will result in instant dismissal from the track and the whole event.

• Any unsafe behaviour will result in dismissal from the track and possibly the whole event.

The event organisers will endeavour to have the event running on time but please be patient as this is the first time this event has been run.

Please remember that unless you have specific insurance your vehicles are not insured while on the track.

The event organisers take no responsibility for damage to vehicles on or off the track.

Gazebos and temporary structures

Only Clubs are permitted to erect a gazebo and must obtain prior permission from the event organiser. Please email fundraiser@hospicesc.org.nz. This must be done in writing and will be granted only if we have the appropriate area for the structure. If weather conditions make it dangerous clubs may be asked to remove the structure. Club members must respect that the event is a family one and any intoxicated, dangerous or obnoxious behaviour will result in possible expulsion from the event. Clubs must assign a named person to be responsible for their club site and ensure that all litter is removed from the site.

Advertising

Strictly no advertising is allowed on any vehicle site, however clubs are invited to display a banner or board with their name etc. No commercial advertising is allowed unless classified as a sponsor by the organisers. No sale of any merchandise, car parts or any form of business is to be carried out by anyone unless previously agreed to in writing by the organising committee.

Our Refund Policy

All Rock and Hop Vehicle entries are non-refundable but are transferable. If you wish to transfer your entry, we must have your new vehicle registration number and contact details. Otherwise entry may not be guaranteed. Please contact us on 03 687 7670
