Mudgee is known for its warm summer days and cool evenings. Our elevation allows for a slower ripening period which makes the area ideal for producing wines with great intensity of colour and flavour.

Originally, grapes were planted here in the 1850's in soils that are typically a red/brown loam with a subsoil rich in clay. This allows for healthy root growth, good water infiltration and aeration.
