Just be sure to have these cuts made and organized by project so we can assemble together on the day. If it says "scraps" just have a hand full of them available to use. You can always make more later with lots more scraps.

Project 1 Scrappy Sunburst Card

7-6 inch by any width decorator card stock strips
A2 card base

Project 2 Mini book

1 piece of 8 1/2 x 11 printer paper
1 piece of card stock 2 3/4 by 4 3/8

Project 3: Scrappy Journaling Cards

Sheet of heavy card stock (old file folder will do)
Pattern paper scraps in multiple sizes. (Patterned paper, old book pages, dictionary pages, ledger paper, any scraps)
Ephemera, lace, buttons, trim, stamps sentiments any decorative scraps.

Project 4 Tri-angle Card

1-A2 card base
1-4 x 5 1/4 base mat
3-1 1/2 x 4 cut in the angle (landscape orientation)

Project 5 River Runs Through It Card

A2 base
4 x 5 1/4 mat
3 x 7 inch scrap

Project 6 Scrap Banner

1 White strip 4x1 long

Project 7 Hidden Paper Clips

1-6x6 Piece of card stock
3-2 inch paper clips
Ribbon or lace scraps
Pattern paper scraps
Ephemera, lace, buttons, trim, stamps sentiments any decorative scraps.
Clear tape (optional)

Project 8 One Sheet Gift Box

1-12 x 12 decorator card stock (preferably with no set orientation)

Project 9 2x2 Note Cards

8- 2 x 4 inch card base
8- 2 inch square scraps
