

INSTALLATION AND USE

- 1. BEFORE CONNECTING THE UNIT TO A POWER SOURCE, SPIN THE BLADE TO ENSURE IT IS FREE OF OBSTRUCTIONS AND DOES NOT CATCH ON OR SCRAPE AGAINST THE FAN HOUSING.
- 2. IDENTIFY AN EASILY ACCESSIBLE LOCATION FOR INSTALLATION OF THE DURABREEZE INLINE FAN. IF NECESSARY, REMOVE A PORTION OF EXISTING DUCTING TO POSITION THE FAN IN PLACE.
- 3. As illustrated, place screws in the mounting bracket holes and place the Rubber inserts, flat sides down, over the screws with the thinner edges facing each other. Rubber pads should be between the bracket and the fan housing. Secure the bracket to the fan by tightening the screws with a ⁵/₁₆" socket or wrench. Securely mount the fan to a supporting wall using the attached mounting brackets.



- 4. SECURE THE OPEN DUCT ENDS TO THE FAN USING DUCT CLAMPS (SOLD SEPARATELY).
- 5. Ensure the power source is the correct voltage to avoid damaging the fan motor. Plug the DuraBreeze Inline Fan into a properly grounded 120V outlet only.
- Note: To maintain optimal performance, regularly unplug the fan and inspect the impeller for obstructions. Wipe away any dirt or debris with a damp cloth.

What This Warranty Covers

This warranty covers defects in materials and workmanship under normal use, with the exceptions stated below.

Who This Warranty Covers

This warranty applies to the original purchaser of this product with the original proof of purchase.

How Long Warranty Coverage Lasts

This warranty is in effect for a period of 5 years from the original date of purchase.

What This Warranty Does Not Cover

This warranty does not cover damage or defects resulting from the improper installation, alteration, abuse, accidental damage, unauthorized repair or misuse of this product. Misuse includes but is not limited to outdoor use.
