

10 WEEK FEED CHART



HOUSE & GARDEN NUTRIENTS AND FERTILIZERS

Mixture

Add part A of the nutrients, wait 15 minutes, then add part B.

Adjust pH:

Aqua 5.7 – 5.9 Cocos 5.8 – 6.3 Soil 5.8 – 6.3

Add the rest of your fertilizers, one at a time.

Never mix A & B directly together.

All measurements are per liter.

Propagation

Use Base and Roots at quarter power.

Modified Feeding Schedules

Flowering week 6: Remove the second and fifth week of the cycle flowering 8 weeks.

Flowering week 7: Remove the second week of the cycle flowering 8 weeks.

Flowering week 9: Repeat week 8 of the 8-week flowering cycle.

Flowering week 12: Repeat the second and fifth week of the cycle 10 weeks flowering.

Aggressive fertilization: Increase basic nutrients by 1–2 mL.

Extended Vegetation:

Repeat the second week, gradually increasing the basic nutrients, as needed.

<u>Tips</u>

ROFESSIONAL TIP:

Use Roots Excelurator at half strength when running on a recirculating system with air stones.

PROFESSIONAL TIP:

Nitrogen Boost is a powerful and highly concentrated formula. Overdosing can cause nitrogen burn.

DO NOT USE TOP SHOOTER AND SHOOTING POWDER AT THE SAME TIME.

DO NOT ADD RHIZO FORCE TO THE RESERVOIR.

PROFESSIONAL TIP:

Add **Bud-XL** at the first sign of flower formation to ensure that the plant's energy is used to create flowers and thus increase production.

PROFESSIONAL TIP:

The yellow color in large leaves is normal after using **Top Booster**.

PROFESSIONAL TIP:

Top Shooter and **Shooting Powder** are the liquid and powder forms of the same high P-K late floral additive (Phosphorus-Potassium).



Using the fertilization chart accurately is the key to success. Only with close monitoring and complete understanding can the true potential of House & Garden Nutrients be realized. Remember that House & Garden is a very concentrated line, so pay close attention to the measurements and take your time to achieve a proper mix.
