

Come explore Dakshineshwar Kali Mandir, a beautiful Hindu temple in Kolkata, West Bengal! The temple was built in 1855 by Rani Rashmoni. It is dedicated to a form of the goddess Kali called Bhavatharini. A statue of Maa Bhavatharini sits in the nine-spired main temple. In the temple complex, there are twelve smaller shrines dedicated to Lord Shiva and

another temple dedicated to Radha-Krishna. Sri Ramakrishna Paramahansa and Swami Vivekananda both emerged from Dakshineshwar Kali Mandir as world famous spiritual leaders who taught that there is divinity in every living being! Happy Coloring!
