

Sri Harmandir Sahib, often referred to as the Golden Temple or Sri Darbār Sahib, is the most significant gurdwara or place of assembly and worship for followers of the Sikh religion. It is located in Amritsar in the state of Punjab. Gurdwara literally translates as "door to the guru", and Harmandir Sahib means "abode of God".

The construction of Harmandir Sahib was ideated and supervised by Guru Arjan Sahib, the Fifth Nanak. Its foundation was laid in 1588, and the temple construction was completed in 1601. Guru Sahib made this beautiful place of worship accessible to all people of all backgrounds. Happy Coloring!
