

Pronunciation Guide for Alphabet Poster

Thamil is considered to be the oldest surviving language spoken today. It is an ancient language with an alphabet and script that has evolved to remain practical and relevant for thousands of years.

Transliteration of Thamil is very subjective. At The Heritage Supply Co., we have created a set of transliterations specifically for English speakers who are interested to learn the Thamil alphabet and basic vocabulary. Please use this pronunciation guide as a tool to help you learn how to best pronounce these words as they are spoken colloquially.

- ah/aa = 'a' in 'father'
- wh/u/a = 'u' in 'under'
- e = 'e' in 'end'
- ₩ E='a' in 'angel'
- i = 'l' in 'India'
- ee = 'ee' in 'bee'
- ai = 'y' in 'try'
- oh = 'o' in 'only'
- O='o' in 'open'
- 00 = 00 in flook
- ooh = 'oo' in 'noodle'
- ou = 'ou' in 'out'
- dh = English 'the'

- 'N' indicates a strong 'na' sound, where the tongue touches the roof of the mouth when the letter is pronounced.
- ** 'L' is a common English transliteration for '617' and indicates a stronger 'la' sound, where the tongue touches the roof of the mouth when the letter is pronounced.
- "I' is a common English transliteration for '\wall' which is a strong 'la' sound in Thamil, where the tongue is placed just below (but not touching) the roof of the mouth. Another common transliteration for this letter is 'zha'.
- ** 'R' indicates a strong 'ra' sound, where the tongue grazes the roof of the mouth when the letter is pronounced.
- Where this is the case, the transliteration of the letter's primary sound will take primary position on the block. Transliterations of contextual sounds will be in smaller font and in parentheses below.
