
MAINTENANCE OF YOUR ROMINA CONVERTIBLE CRIB:

DO NOT USE CRIB IF PARTS ARE DAMAGED OR BROKEN! CONTACT YOUR DEALER OR ROMINA FURNITURE FOR ASSISTANCE AND REPLACEMENT PARTS. PLEASE BE SURE TO HAVE YOUR MODEL CODE WRITTEN DOWN BEFORE YOU MAKE CONTACT. THE MODEL CODE CAN BE FOUND ON A WHITE LABEL LOCATED ON THE INSIDE OF YOUR CRIB ON THE SIDE PANEL.


STEP 1 (For all ROMINA cribs - one adult is required to complete this step)


Take the mattress support (MS) of your crib and position it so the springs of the mesh will face upside and the metallic pins found nearby the metallic brackets will face downside (please see FIGURE 1A).


The proper orientation of the mattress support is very important for the correct assembling and usage of the crib Rotate all the metallic brackets until they are stopped by the metallic pins (please see FIGURE 1B).











STEP 2 (Two adults are required to complete this step)


Attach mattress support (MS) to the left and right panels (LP & RP) using four Allen bolts (4), four washers (5) and the Allen key. Take care to insert the washer between the bolt. Use soft surface during installation (blanket or carpet) to avoid damage to crib's finish.


Do not completely tighten the bolts at this step, you will be asked to do this in step 4.



STEP 3 (One adult is required to complete this step)

Attach the footboard (FB) and headboard (HB) to the left and right panels (LP & RP) using eight Allen bolts (4), eight washers (5) and the Allen key. Take care to insert the washer between the bolt and the vertical post of the panel!

Completely tighten all 8 Allen bolts (4+5) used to attach the footboard and headboard.


REMINDER

You have to completely tighten **8** Allen bolts, distributed as following:

- 4 bolts (4+5) in the footboard.
- 4 bolts (4+5) in the headboard.

WARNING: TO KEEP YOUR BABY SECURE AND SAFE, AND TO AVOID POTENTIAL INJURY OR DEATH, IT'S VERY I M P O R T A N T T O COMPLETELY TIGHTEN ALL 8 BOLTS.

STEP 4 (One adult is required to complete this step)

Completely tighten all 4 Allen bolts (3+5) used to attach the mattress support.



- 4 bolts (3+5) in the left and right panels (LP & RP).

STEP 5 (Two adults are required to complete this step)

Carefully turn crib on back side (FIGURE 5) after completing **STEP 4** Place crib on soft surface (blanket or carpet).

Attach the decorative legs (DL) to the crib using 12 Allen bolts (3), 12 washers (5), and the Allen key. Take care to insert the washer between the bolt and the decorative leg!

Completely tighten all 12 Allen bolts (3+5) used to attach the decorative legs.

You have to completely tighten 12 Allen bolts, distributed as following: - 12 bolts (3+5) in the decorative legs.
