Application to Galway County Council for a Waste Facility Permit

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Articles 7 and 8 of the Waste Management (Facility Permit and Registration) Regulations 2007 (as amended) that Bruscar Bhearna Teoranta of Carrowbrowne, Headford Road, Galway, Co. Galway intends to apply for a Waste Facility Permit to Operate a Waste Transfer Facility at Pollboy, Ballinasloe, Co. Galway. The application for a Waste Facility Permit to Operate a Waste Transfer Facility will be made to Galway County Council within 10 working days of the date of this notice.
