

### Is my watch waterproof?

All our watches are waterproof, but in a different extent to the watch model. Information on water resistance is located on the case back. The term "waterproof" is usually given by a printing of e.g. 100M / 10 bar / 10 ATM (Atmospheres) supplemented.

The information on water resistance refers to the time of the test. The seals may lose some of their elastic properties over time due to confounding factors (sun, showering, salt water, perspiration). Even impacts against the crown or pushers can affect the water resistance. Therefore, the waterproofness cannot be guaranteed indefinitely.

To be on the safe side, have your watch checked for water resistance every year. In addition, you should avoid bringing a tightly heated watch into contact with liquids (for example, when you go into the water after sunbathing), because the pressure ratio in the watch suddenly changes and moisture can be drawn in.
