STEP 1 - PREPARE

- Make an **Emergency Plan**. Before a disaster strikes, set a plan with your family to know how to contact one another and reconnect if separated.
- home, and an <u>Emergency Supply Kit</u> in your home, and an <u>Emergency Car Kit</u> in your vehicle. It's best to avoid traveling, but if it is necessary, it's important to have essential items. 72HRS has various <u>Emergency Kits!</u> Choose one that best suites your needs.
- Clean leaves, garbage, ice and other debris away from the storm drains near your home.
- Having **light** to see is very important!

 Keep a flashlight in a place that is familiar and easy to access in case of a power outage. Having at least one

 Hand-crank Flashlight in your house is a good idea as it does not rely on batteries.
- Obtain **home insurance** with flood coverage.
- Put **sealant** around basement windows and the base of ground-level doors. Add window wells and covers to windows that are near or below ground level.

STEP 2 - DURING

- Radio and television stations will broadcast weather statements. Pay attention to that information. Keep a

 NOAA radio in your emergency kit
- When a flood or flash flood warning is issued for your area, head for higher ground and stay there.
- Avoid walking and driving through flooded waters. They could be deeper than you think.
- Be especially **cautious at night** when it is harder to recognize flood danger.
- Keep children and pets away from flood water.

STEP 3 - AFTER

- Follow directions from **local authorities** and **first responder personnel.**
- Maintain **good hygiene** during flood cleanup by minimizing contact with floodwater or anything that may have come in contact with it.
- Wear **protective clothing**, including rubber boots or sturdy boots, **safety glasses**, **hard hat**, rubber gloves and **a dust mask.**
- Check with local authorities or community leaders on how to properly dispose of damaged items from your home.
- Do not use any appliances, heating, pressure, or sewage system until electrical components are dry and have been inspected by a qualified electrician.
