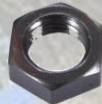
T3 Bolt

If and when the pivot bolts are replaced, it is recommended to rub a small amount of loc-tite onto the thread of the bolt. This will secure the bolt in place once screwed into the locking nut or bush.

NB: The T3 bolt is the only bolt that should be used with the bush.

It is also recommended to mark the bolts (especially the T2 and T3 bolts) before you disassemble anything for replacement, so there is no mix up when putting back together.

For regular users, we also suggest the bushes are replaced once per season, and keep them lubricated with white lithium grease.

Sharpening the blades must also be done on a regular basis to ensure the tool works at its optimum level. These blades are an anvil operation, and therefore need to be sharpened on both sides, following the bevel with a fine or medium grit file.

If the blade is blunt, you will put too much pressure on the cut and risk damaging the branch and tool. The maximum cut for the 60cm loppers is 40mm and the 80cm loppers is 45mm.
