

Maruyoshi Flax Cutter user guide...

The Japanese Flax Cutter is a great hand tool for cutting all fibrous plants like flax, agapanthus, kikuyu grass and cabbage trees.

It is a sickle with razor sharp teeth (it's not a wood saw), and the serrated blade only works when you are pulling the tool back towards you.

The Maruyoshi Flax Cutter is incredibly light and made from high quality carbon steel and the blade is tempered to give long lasting durability. It also features a reinforced back bar designed to add extra strength to the blade.

Simply hold the plant firmly and pull the tool towards you. And when used correctly, and on the right materials, the flax cutter blade should not bend or break.

Maintenance:

Although these tools are made from high quality steel, they can still rust if not properly maintained. We recommend you clean and dry the blades after use and then store away in a moisture-free place.
