
PREVIEW OF DIGITAL TASK CARDS



HOW BOOM CARDS WORK

You will need an internet connection to use them as noted in the description and preview.

When you purchase, you will download a PDF file with a link to your digital cards on the BOOM Platform.

When you click the link and travel to the BOOM LearningSM website, you will be given a free account if you do not have one already. With the free account you can use the cards using Fast Pin, but you will not be able to collect data.



If you choose not to stay on a premium account after your free trial, you will still be able to assign all your Boom Cards to as many students as you see fit using Fast Play pins (which give instant feedback for decks that are self-grading).


The digital cards will be housed on the platform (not downloaded) and you will assign students to a class in order for them to use them.



WHAT'S INCLUDED

- 88 digital task cards on the BOOM LearningSM
 Platform
 - 24 have words in the signs
 - 64 have no words in the signs
 - Each have 3 choices
- The cards give students auditory and visual feedback with a sound and red circle around the wrong answer. If they get the right answer, they hear and chime and it moves to the next card.







HOW TO USE THEM

- After accessing your cards with the link on the page in the download, you will have a free account on BOOM LearningSM
- You can then assign the cards to your students remotely through a variety of learning management platforms including: Google Classroom, Schoology, SeeSaw, Canvas, Moodle, Powerschool, Class Dojo, and Microsoft Teams.
- You can work through them on a video conferencing site with students as well through screensharing.
- In a physical classroom, you can use them on an interactive whiteboard for students to take turns practicing on
- Have students access the platform on a tablet to practice independently or in an independent work system
