

What's Included Overview

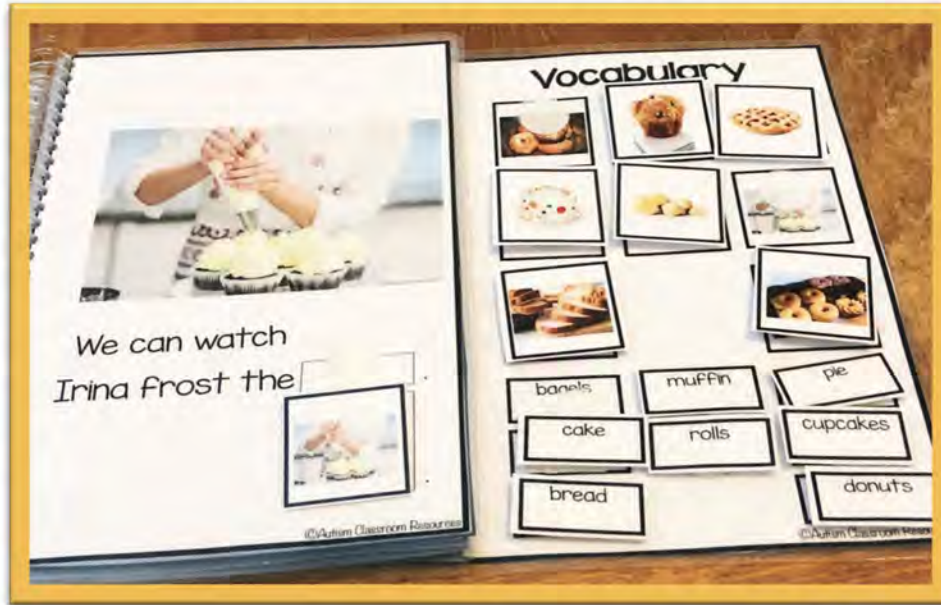
- ❑ 12 interactive books incorporating 100 food words
- ❑ All the books use photographs of the food items
- ❑ The books are designed to be interactive in that students find the word to match the picture on the page.
- ❑ To allow easier differentiation among students in the classroom, I also included pictures (without words) for students to simply match the pictures to the page. I talk about this more later..
- ❑ Choice board visuals to fit into the morning meeting starter kit book or story boards if you are using them.
- ❑ The picture cards can be stored on an extension page that have matching pictures. There are 2 options—one has matching pictures and the other is a blank page with no pictures so you can rearrange them.

These books work well in conjunction with the Functional Sight Word Task Cards (Food), Food Sight Word Bingo, Food Sight Word Worksheets, and Food Sight Word File Folders.

What's Included Overview

Each book comes with 2 picture-word holding page options.



The standard page has matching pictures and words. The words and pictures are in the same order, so some very astute students might notice that and use it as a cue. However, for those students, use the page below to mix it up.

The plain page allows you to just put the words or just the pictures. Or you can put both of them on it but mix up the order regularly. This prevents students from memorizing where the right answers are.

Shopping at the Fruit Stand

Sam shops at the fruit stand for a variety of fruit include lemons, limes, watermelon, grapes, bananas, apples, oranges, pears and strawberries.



Shannon Makes a Salad

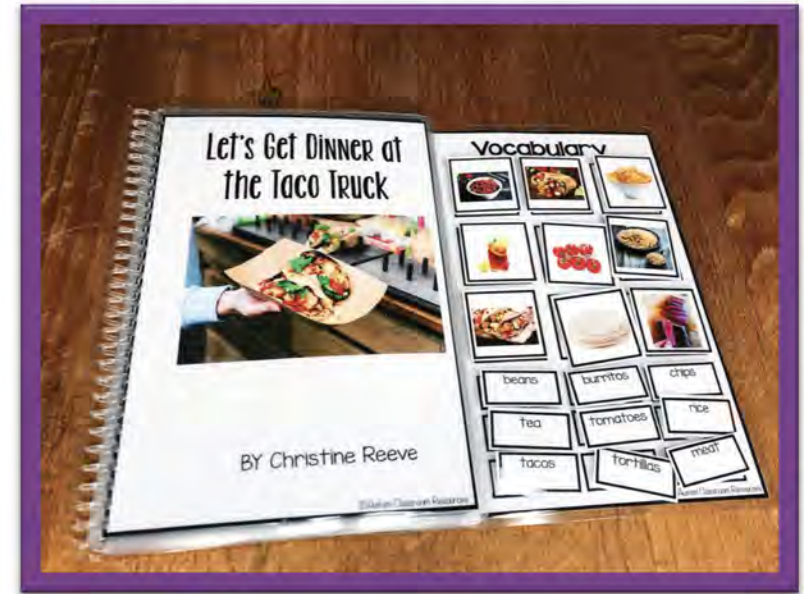
Focus words: salad, lettuce, tomatoes, cucumber, onion, avocado, peppers, roll and water all within the context of making a salad and preparing lunch.



What's Included: Details of Books

Let's Get Dinner at the Taco Truck

Written without characters, this book asks questions like "Do you like fish ___ [tacos]?" The reader fills in the missing word and you can talk about if they like tacos and what kind. Reading comprehension words include tacos, rice, beans, tortillas, meat, tomatoes, burritos, tea, and chips.



Mike and Kira Grab Fast Food

This book focuses on the food and condiments the main characters eat. In addition to the reading words, you can ask who questions about who ordered which items. Vocabulary includes soda, milkshake, onion rings, burger, hot dog, French fries, ketchup, mustard and cookie.

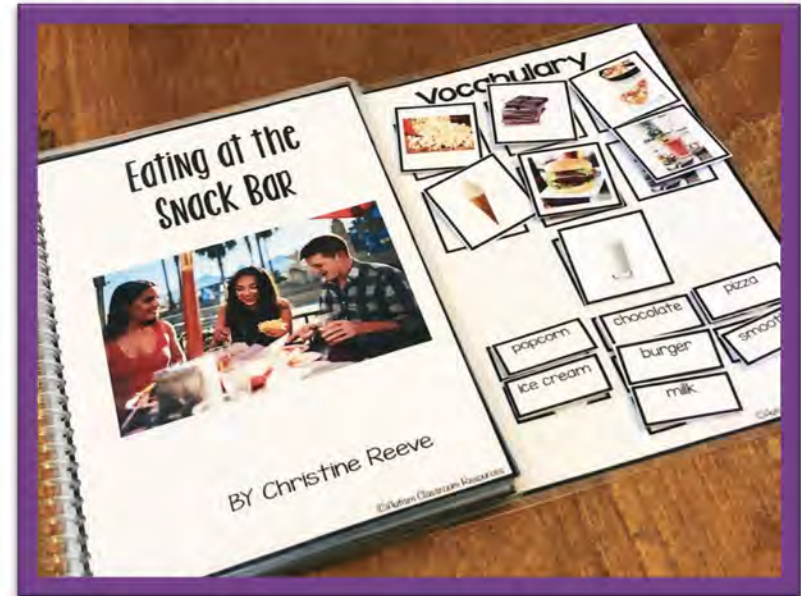


What's Included: Details of Books

Eating at the Snack Bar

This book was written with three characters with specific orders at the snack bar. This allows asking who questions in addition to the reading comprehension tasks. Target reading words include: popcorn, ice cream, burger, yogurt, milk, smoothie and pizza.

The Morgans Went Out to Breakfast

This book focuses on a breakfast buffet and what the family can eat. There are some individual lines for asking who questions (e.g., who had coffee?).

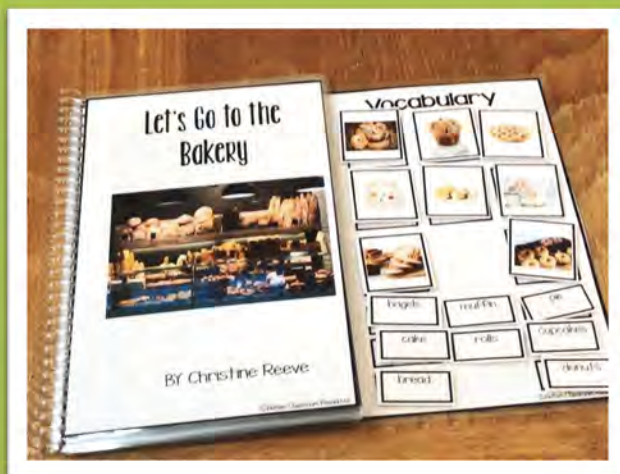
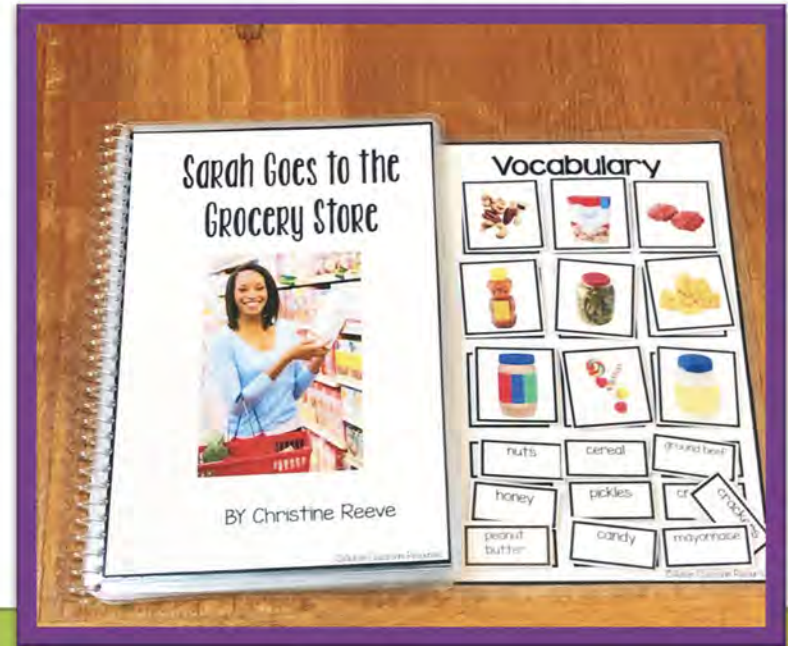


Vocabulary includes coffee, orange juice, eggs, pancakes, waffles, breakfast sandwich, bacon, sausage, and toast.

What's Included: Details of Books

Sarah Goes to the Grocery Store

Sarah is doing the grocery shopping and getting multiple items on her list. Vocabulary includes peanut butter, nuts, cereal, ground beef, honey, pickles, crackers, mayonnaise, and candy.



Let's Go to the Bakery

Focusing on bakery goods, this book has no main characters, but 2 characters work at the bakery (icing cupcakes and slicing bread).



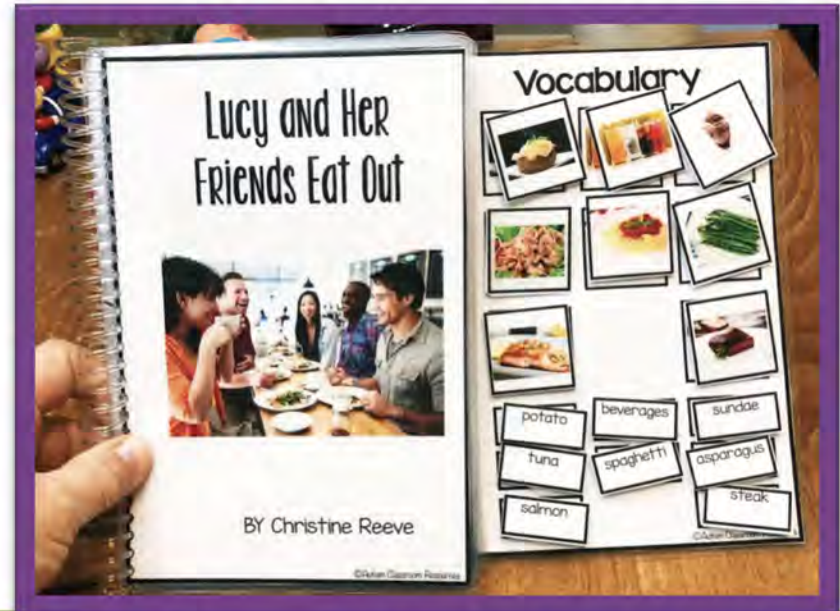
Vocabulary includes bagels, cupcakes, muffin, donuts, bread, rolls, cake, and pie.

Lucy and Her Friends Eat Out

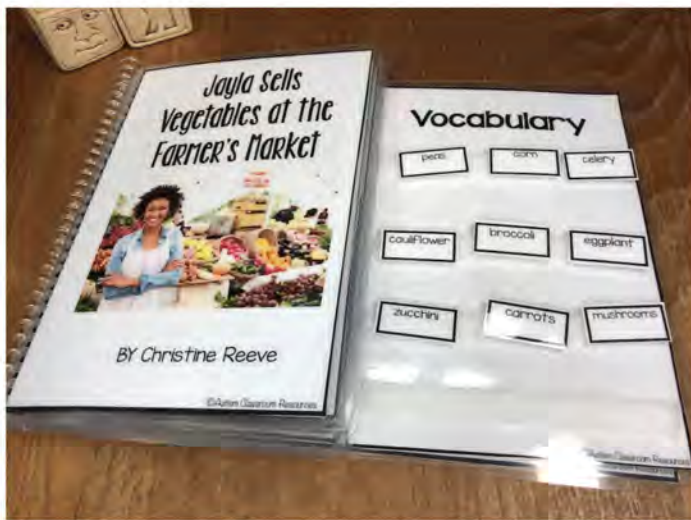
This book revolves around a group of friends dining out and what they order. You can build who questions about who orders what.

Vocabulary includes potato, beverages, asparagus, beef steak, salmon, spaghetti, tuna and sundae.

The book is shown here with the optional blank page holder without pictures (the pictures are inside the book). Different characters make purchases, allowing for what and who questions.



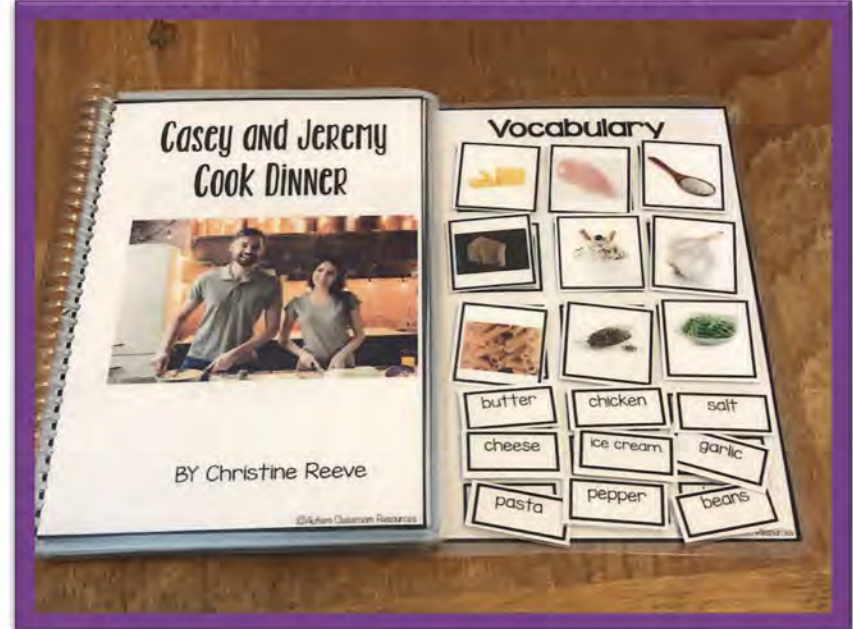
Vocabulary includes broccoli, eggplant, celery, carrots, zucchini, peas, mushroom, corn, and cauliflower.

Casey and Jeremy Cook Dinner

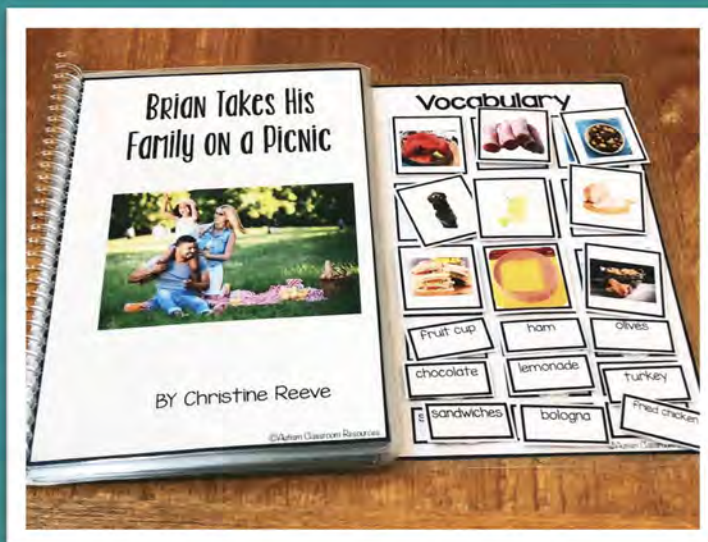
Preparing a meal is the theme of this book as the characters cook a chicken dish.
