More than 300 toxic chemicals and 150 carcinogens may be present in conventional oil-based paint, according to a Johns Hopkins University study. In reaction to consumers' concerns over the environmental and health risks associated with their products, conventional paint manufacturers have begun to reformulate their paints to reduce volatile organic compounds (VOC's). While this is a step in the right direction, we believe the paint industry still has a long way to go. For starters, VOC's are not the only toxins in paints, so even a zero-VOC paint can be can be hazardous to your health and the environment. The heart of the problem is that paint manufacturers are not required to disclose all of their ingredients and most of them don't, which makes it very dicult for consumers to assess "non-toxic" and "ecofriendly" claims. We believe that full ingredient disclosure should be the norm in the paint industry and are hoping that other paint companies will follow our lead.
