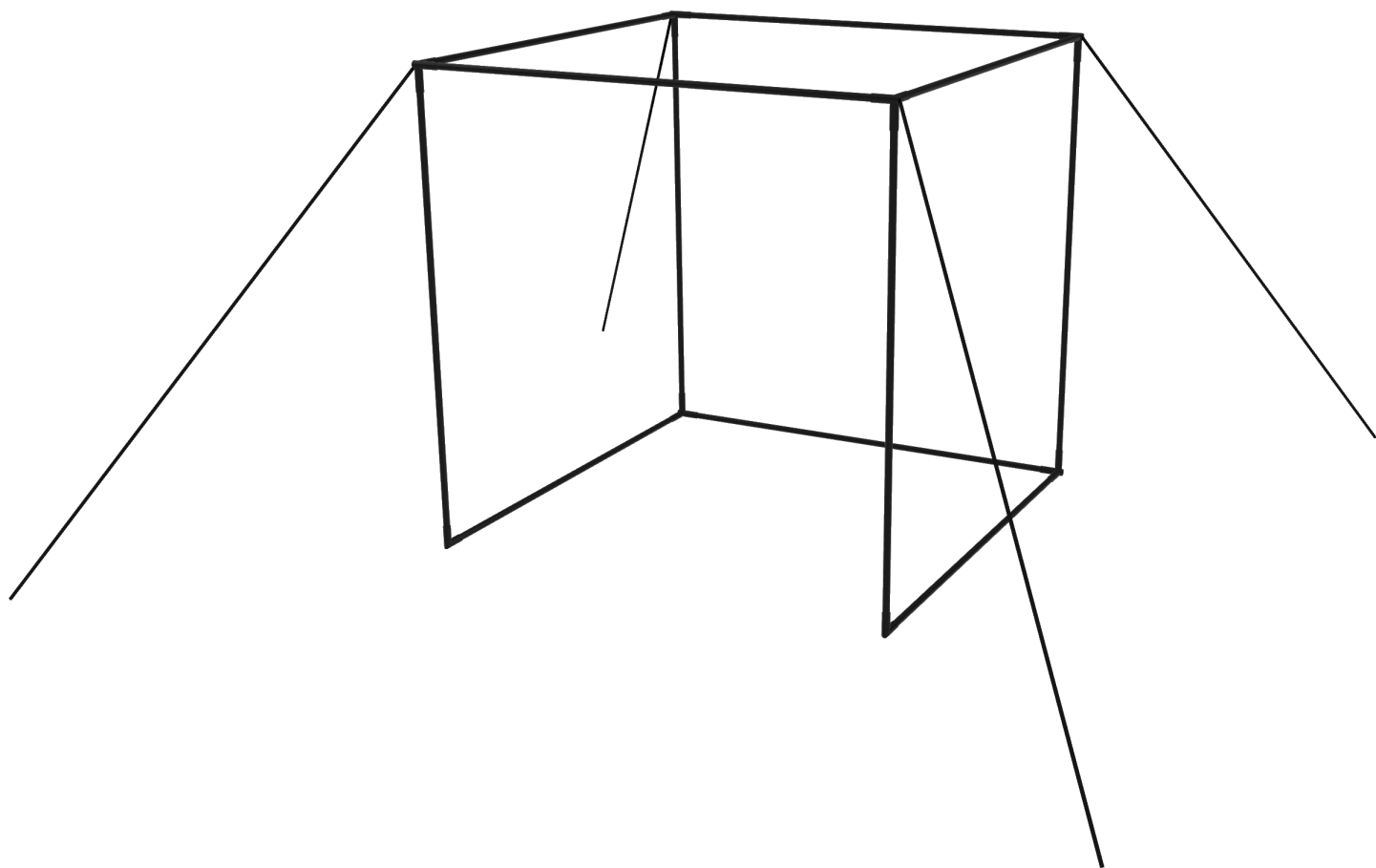


GOLF CAGE STAKE DOWN KIT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



ABOUT THE STAKES

The Golf Stake Down Kit can be used with our golf cages to help stabilize the cage during heavy ball impact and light winds. If you are expecting high winds please **remove** your net. Netting will act like a sail, and create tremendous strain on the framework.

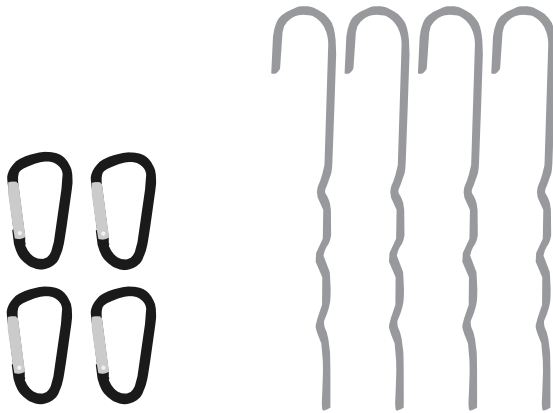
1-3/8" GOLF CAGE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Read these instructions fully before starting the assembly process. Please make sure you have all of your parts and pieces. If not, contact our customer service.

What's Included

- (4) Kinked stakes
- (1) 300ft Rope
- (4) Carabiner clips



1) Cut the Rope & Tie

Cut the rope into 4 sections that are approximately 25ft long. At one end of the rope, double it over and tie a loop. Pull the loop around the frame corner as shown and pull the opposite end of the rope through the loop.

2) Attach Carabiners & Drive Stakes

At the opposite end of the rope, tie another loop and clip on a carabiner. Pull the rope tight at a 45° angle and drive the stake into ground using a rubber mallet or hammer. We recommend to tie a loop in the rope near the end of the stake in order to cinch the rope tightly and to allow for a bit of tension adjustment once all the stakes are in the ground.
