# Yeti Bag

## Overview

Designed to accompany our [Leather Handle Kit - Short](#), the Yeti Bag is both fun and fuzzy. Knit from the bottom up with a Provisional Cast-On, you can easily modify this bag to be as large or small as you'd like. With such a simple pattern, you can really adapt it to be anything you want - the possibilities are endless. Maintain the texture of the Baby Yeti yarn by throwing it in the dryer on low heat for a few minutes. Easily add and remove the handles for washing with their minimal no-sew design. Paired together, this bag and these handles are a woolly perfect match.

## Finished Measurements

Circumference: 18" / 46 cm

Depth: 12" / 20 cm

## Yarn

Approximately 70 yards / 65 meters of bulky weight yarn that gets gauge

Big Bad Wool Baby Yeti

85% Baby Alpaca, 15% Fine Merino Wool; 109 yds / 100 m per 3.5 oz / 100 g skein  
1 skein in Natural

A Verb For Keeping Warm Lambkin

70% Highland Wool, 30% Alpaca; 87 yds / 80 m per 3.5 oz / 100 g skein  
1 skein

## Needles

US 10.5 / 6.5 mm (or size for fabric you like) 32" circular needle. Needle should be long enough to do Magic Loop (or use dpns)

Extra US 10.5 / 6.5 mm dpn or circ for working PCO

US 10.5 / 6.5 mm 16" circular needle (optional for knitting body of bag)

US 5 / 3.75 mm needle (optional for Jeny's Stretchy BO)

## Notions

2 stitch markers in different colors

## Gauge

12 sts and 16 rnds = 4" / 10 cm square in St st.

**NOTE:** Gauge is not terribly important—it's more important that you get a fabric that suits you.

## Abbreviations/Special Techniques

### **JENY'S STRETCHY BO**

### **KNIT FRONT & BACK (KF&B)**

Knit into the front, then the back of stitch (inc 1 st).

### **MODIFIED MAGIC LOOP**

*Watch how-to on knit tutorial section of our website.* (How to Knit Around Corners Using Modified Magic Loop.)

### **PCO: PROVISIONAL CAST ON**

We recommend Judy's magic CO. *Watch how-to on knit tutorial section of our website.*

## Instructions

PCO 12 sts.

**Set-up Rnd (RS):** K12, pm. Using the Modified Magic Loop, k12 sts on opposite side of CO, pm of different color for beginning of round. 24 sts.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** \*K1, kf&b, knit to 2 st before m, kf&b, k1 sl m; rep from \* (4 sts inc'd). 28 sts.

**Rnd 2:** Knit.

Repeat these two rnds until you have 60 sts or desired bag width.

Work even until desired bag height (sample was approx 12" / 20 cm tall from CO edge). BO loosely or use smaller needles (US 5) and Jeny's Stretchy BO.

## Finishing

Weave in ends and follow washing/drying directions on yarn label.

For Baby Yeti yarn you can wash on gentle and dry on low heat, checking frequently.
