# **HISTORY**

1962 to 76	Painted and exhibited in England, Spain, and Canada
1977	Began the <i>Bridgetown Series</i> , a group of over 200 paintings that form a narrative about the life of a rural Nova Scotian town
1978	Opened the Tolmie Gallery in Bridgetown, NS; the Gallery subsequently moved to Mahone Bay, NS (1993) and Toronto, ON (2000)
1978 to 1984	Involved in the artistic and cultural affairs of Nova Scotia: acted on the Board of the Art Gallery of Nova Scotia; founded the James House Museum in Bridgetown; and donated several pieces to support cultural causes
1985 to 1993	Began phase one of the <i>Window Series</i> in Toronto, transforming his earlier narrative realist technique into more technically and thematically complex engagement with urban environments and modes of perception
1993 to 1999	Returned to Nova Scotia, and founded Tolmie Productions to make films on Canadian art
2000 to 2004	Moved to Toronto and began phase two of the <i>Window Series</i> , undertaking larger and more ambitious works in oil; exhibited commercially in Austin, Texas and in Eastern Canada
2005 to present	Resides and works in Kitchener-Waterloo, Ontario
