


QUICK GUIDE

BP-1 COMPACT BASS PREAMP/D.I.



- 1. This is where you connect the cable from your bass.
- 2. Main output to FOH/Mixing desk.
 - Transformer balanced 3-pin XLR male bushing pin 2 is hot, pin 3 is cold, and pin 1 is ground/screen.
- 3. SEND this signal goes to the input of your first stomp box.
- 4. RETURN connect the output of your last stomp box to this 1/4" jack.
- 5. Isolated Tuner Output. Always active.
- 6. Additional transformer isolated 1/4" TRS output to feed an external amplifier. The amplifier connected must be earthed/grounded.
- 7. 12VDC @ 400mA. Center negative. Will accept both 2.1 and 2.5mm plug.

The series loop is placed after the input buffer, but before the actual bass preamp.

Here's a Quick Guide to how you start out:

- 1. Power up the BP1C with the required power supply.
- 2. Activate the MUTE switch (LED on) on the BP1C.
- 3. Connect your instrument with a high quality 1/4" jack cable.
- 4. Connect stomp boxes to SEND/RETURN, and your external monitor/Amplifier to AMP OUT.
- 5. Connect the BP1C D.I. to a Mic.Input channel on the FOH/Mixing Desk with a high quality mic cable.
- 6. Set both the BP1C GAIN and LEVEL at 11 o'clock. This is a good starting point.
- 7. Deactivate the MUTE switch on the BP1C (LED off) and adjust the input gain on the Mixing Desk.
- 8. You are now good to go. Enjoy your BP1C.
