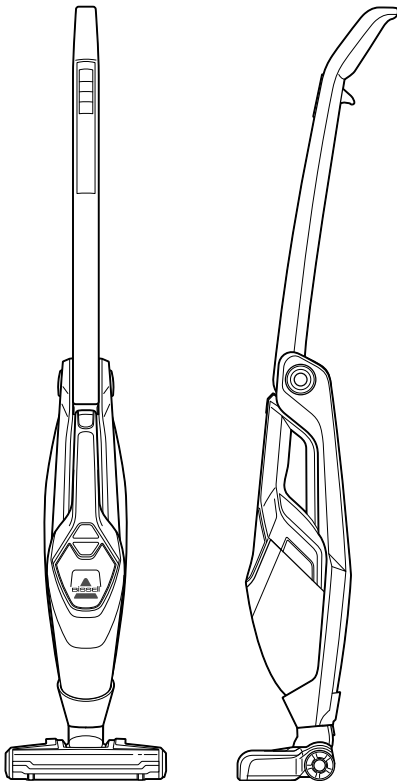

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING YOUR VACUUM.

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should be observed, including the following:



WARNING

TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR INJURY:

- » This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- » Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- » If charger supply cable is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- » Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts of the appliance and its accessories.
- » Unplug from electrical socket when not charging.
- » Do not allow to be used as a toy.
- » Use only as described in this user guide.
- » Use only BISSELL recommended attachments.
- » Do not use with damaged cable or plug for charger.
- » Do not immerse in water or liquid.
- » If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water; do not attempt to operate it and return it to a service center.
- » Do not pull or carry charger by cable.
- » Keep charger cable away from heated surfaces.
- » Do not unplug charger by pulling on cable.
- » To unplug charger, grasp the plug, not the cable.
- » Do not handle charger plug or appliance with wet hands.
- » Do not put any object into openings.
- » Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- » Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- » Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as petroleum, or use in areas where they may be present.
- » Do not pick up toxic material (chlorine bleach, ammonia, drain cleaner, etc.)
- » Do not use appliance in an enclosed space filled with vapours given off by oil base paint, paint thinner, some mothproofing substances, flammable dust, or other explosive or toxic vapours.
- » Do not pick up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws, coins, etc.
- » Use only on dry, indoor surfaces.
- » Keep appliance on a level surface.
- » Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- » Do not use without dust tank and/or filters in place.
- » Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces
- » Do not leave machine running in the same spot without handle fully upright.
- » Turn off all controls before connecting or disconnecting the TurboBrush® Tool or Pet TurboEraser® Tool.
- » Only use the rechargeable Li-ion battery pack and charging base supplied by BISSELL.
- » If the appliance is to be stored unused for a long period, the battery pack should be removed.
- » Battery pack and charger base output terminals are not to be short-circuited.


To start cleaning select the power button to turn the unit on.

2




Select the +/- button to adjust the suction power.

Select the brush button to turn the motorized brush roll off and on.

Select the edge reach button to turn the edge cleaning mode off and on.

NOTE: The brush roll will be ON when the stick vacuum is turned ON. Having the brush roll ON may improve cleaning on soft surfaces such as low-pile area rugs.


Operating 2-Way Folding Handle

Find the 2-Way folding handle trigger located under the handle.


Pull the trigger to fold the handle.

Fold the handle back for easy storage.

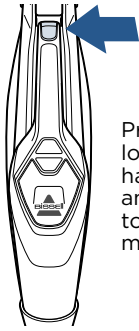

Fold the handle forward to easily clean underneath low places.

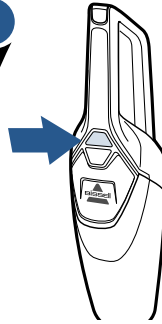
Removable Hand Vacuum

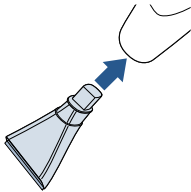
Press the button located on top of the hand vacuum handle and lightly pull out to remove it from the machine.

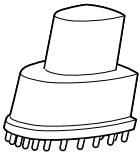


Press the power button to begin cleaning.

Hand Vacuum Tools



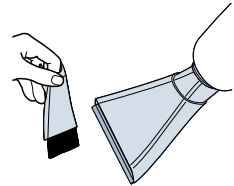
Your purchase may come with specially designed tools designed to make pet cleanup easier. To use any of the tools, remove the hand vacuum from the base of the machine and insert the desired tool firmly in to the hand vacuum nozzle.



Pet and Debris Nozzle Tool has rubberized teeth to pull and lift up embedded hair and dirt.

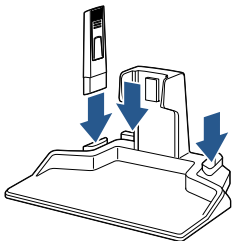


Crevice Tool with Dusting Brush reaches narrow spaces and is delicate on upholstery.



Sweep and Scoop Tool makes it easier to sweep in and vacuum up debris.

Charging Base Tool Storage



The charging base will recharge your stick vacuum and also store the tools. There are up to three spots to store the tools to your hand vacuum on the charging base.

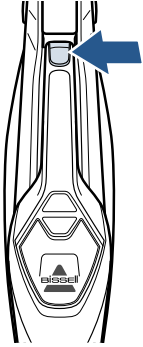
Reminder: The charging port on the base is located underneath.

Maintenance: Emptying the Dirt Cup

WARNING

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock or injury, turn power OFF and disconnect plug from electrical outlet before performing maintenance or troubleshooting.

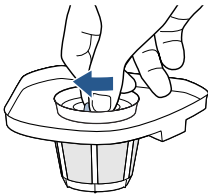
Make sure the vacuum is OFF. Remove the hand vacuum by pressing the release button on its top handle.

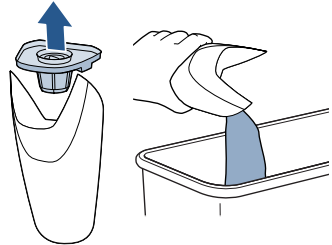
Find the dirt cup removal button and press to remove the dirt cup from hand vacuum.

3



With the dirt cup removed, locate the filter removal tab in the center of the filter assembly. Firmly grasp the tab and turn clockwise (to the right) to operate the Clean-Turn feature. As you turn the tab, the filter will turn and help clean off excess dirt and debris.

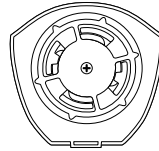
Firmly grasp the tab and pull up to remove the filter from the dirt cup. Empty the dirt cup into a waste receptacle.

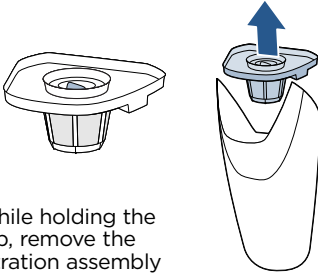
Maintenance: Filters

TIP: It may be helpful to turn the filter assembly over and view the underside locking parts before completing steps 1 - 6.



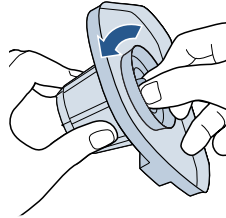
underside view of filter

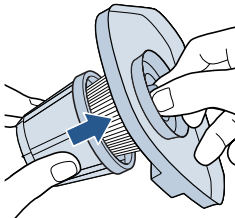
While holding the tab, remove the filtration assembly from the dirt cup.

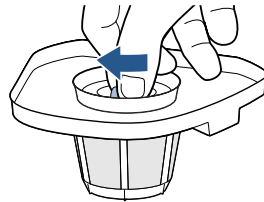
To disassemble for thorough cleaning, firmly grasp the filter assembly tab with one hand and the mesh filter frame with the other. Turn the tab to the left (counterclockwise) to unlock from the mesh filter frame.

To re-assemble the filter, insert the pleated filter into the mesh filter frame.

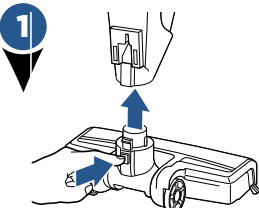
While firmly holding the mesh filter frame, turn the tab to the right (clockwise) to lock the pieces together.

NOTE: You may rinse the filter and frame in warm water to clean. The filter and frame need to be 100% dry before reuse. The key to maximum performance is having a clean filter. Cleaning the filter after each use will help your vacuum operate at peak efficiency.

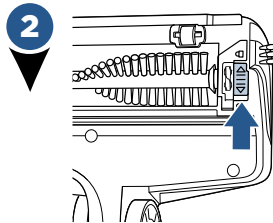
Maintenance: Brush Roll

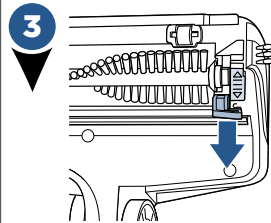
Do not operate your BOLT® LITHIUM MAX with damp or wet filters or without filters in place.



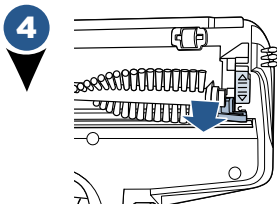
1 Make sure the vacuum is OFF. Press the foot release button to disconnect it from the vacuum.



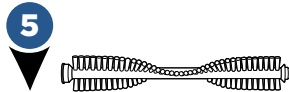
2 Turn the foot over and locate the brush roll cover tab.



3 Slide the tab down to un-lock and lift the corner cover piece.



4 Grasp the brush roll and remove from the foot window area.



5 Clean your brush roll as needed and place back into foot. Make sure the brush roll cover tab is locked back into place to prevent breaking or faulty brush roll operation.

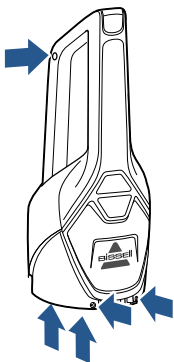
BRUSH ROLL RESET:

If larger debris becomes lodged in the foot and the brush roll shuts off, turn the unit off and remove the obstruction. Wait approximately 15 seconds for the motor to cool down before turning back on. Brush will function again after allowing time to cool down.

Maintenance: Disposal of Batteries

NOTICE

Disconnecting the battery will destroy the appliance and invalidate the warranty.



- Unplug the charger.
- Remove hand vac from unit and remove dirt cup from handle.
- Remove (2) Phillips head screws and remove the lens from the hand vacuum.
- Remove (2) Phillips head screws from the hand vacuum cover.
- Lift off the hand vacuum cover and take out the push rod.
- Remove (5) Phillips head screws from the side of the hand vacuum.
- Remove the entire battery assembly from the cover.
- Cut wires from the PCB and wrap the wire ends with insulation tape.
- Keep Battery Pack together - DO NOT separate individual batteries. For specific disposal instructions of batteries, please follow local regulations.
- Hand in remainder of product at an official collection point for recycling.

Troubleshooting

WARNING

Problem	Possible causes	Remedies
Vacuum won't turn on	Battery isn't fully charged	Charge battery. Follow charging battery instructions on page 5
	Wrong charger being used	Be sure to use only the charger supplied with your product. The label on the detachable hand vacuum will list which charger can be used.
Brush roll not turning	Brush roll is jammed	Remove obstruction. Follow instructions on page 10
	Brush roll needs to be reset	Follow instructions on page 10
	Broken brush roll belt	Visit www.bissell.com
Vacuum cleaner has low suction	Dirt container is full	Empty dirt container
	Dirt container is not installed properly	Position container correctly and snap firmly into place
	Foot is loose	Make sure foot is fully inserted into body of unit
	Filters need cleaning	Follow filter instructions on page 9
	Filters need replacing	Visit www.bissell.com
	Clog or obstruction in foot area	Detach foot from main body and examine and remove clog from ports
Visible dirt escaping from cleaner	Dirt container is full of debris	Empty dirt container
	Filter is missing or installed incorrectly	Check filter for correct installation
	Dirt container installed incorrectly	Position container correctly and snap firmly into place
Vacuum won't charge	Not the correct charger	Use only the charger that comes with the machine
