#### 1) Check the brush ends for debris build-up or broken belt.

- a. Turn machine off & unplug from wall outlet.
- b. Remove solution & collection tanks.
- c. Lie machine down to access the bottom of the machine.
- d. With a Phillips head screwdriver, unscrew the belt cover & remove.
- e. Brush can now be removed.
- f. Belt can be removed by sliding off the motor pulley.
- g. Clean or replace brush or belt if necessary. Attach belt to motor pulley & brush, insert brush into right side end cap.
- h. Reattach the left end cap and slide brush back into place.
- i. Replace the belt cover & screw into place.
- j. Manually rotate brush to make sure it rotates freely and that the belt is aligned properly.
