Please feel free to write your own announcements. It is helpful to reserve place in the parish bulletin for announcements about *Lenten Longings* so that people will know where to look. If you provide information about *Lenten Longings* two to four weeks ahead of time, people are ready for the invitation when it comes on Sign-up Sunday. The idea is to whet appetites and let parishioners know something wonderful is coming and that they won't want to miss it. You can adapt these to suit your parish; put a contact name and number as well.
