Pairing Instruction for the Twin-Tube System

- 1. Disconnect all power from the receiver.
- 2. Activate the transmitter by pushing the ON button located on the front.
- 3. To insure an uninterrupted signal, locate yourself with the transmitter in a position near the receiver.
- 4. Restore power to the receiver.
- 5. Within 10 seconds of restoring power to the receiver, simultaneously push the top 3 buttons on the transmitter (front raise, boat raise, rear raise) and hold for 4 seconds.

Note. When pairing an <u>additional</u> transmitter to a receiver, it's important to turn all of the primary (original) transmitters off while the new unit is being paired. The receiver will only listen to one transmitter at a time, by turning the primary transmitter(s) off, you simultaneously send a log-out command to the receiver.

Instructions for Tri-Tube system.

- 1. Disconnect all power from the receiver.
- 2. Activate the transmitter by pushing the ON button located on the front.
- 3. To insure an uninterrupted signal, locate yourself with the transmitter in a position near the receiver.
- 4. Restore power to the receiver.
- 5. Within 10 seconds of restoring power to the receiver, simultaneously push buttons 1 & 2 on the transmitter and hold for 4 seconds.

Note. When pairing an <u>additional</u> transmitter to a receiver, it's important to turn all of the primary (original) transmitters off while the new unit is being paired. The receiver will only listen to one transmitter at a time, by turning the primary transmitter(s) off, you simultaneously send a log-out command to the receiver.
