

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QUILT PATTERN

MAKE SURE YOU: Have Fun Stay Curious

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PATTERN NOTES

- WOF = Width of Fabric
- RST = Right Sides Together
- Press all fabrics before cutting F8 = Fat Eighth (9" x 21")
- Seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted
- Pattern assumes WOF is 42" to 45" Press all seams open unless otherwise noted
 - FQ = Fat Quarter (18" x 21")

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

• A	1¼ Yards
В	1/2 Yard
Backing	1¼ Yards
Binding	3/8 Yard

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric Description	Wall Hanging/Baby 40" x 40"
• A1	(4) 40½'' x 3½''
• A2	(2) 21½" x 3½"
• A3	(2) 19" × 10½"
• A4	(12) 7" x 3½"
• A5	(1) 3½" x 3½"
B1	(3) 27½" x 3½"
B2	(1) 21½" x 3½"
B3	(1) 10½'' x 3½''
B4	(5) 3½" x 3½"
Backing	WOF x 45"
Binding	(5) 2½'' x WOF

MAKING THE COLUMNS

- 1. Place A4, RST with B1. (Fig 1)
- 2. Sew together and press seam.
- 3. Place A4, RST as shown in the diagram. (Fig 2)
- 4. Sew together and press seam. (Fig 3)
- 5. Repeat steps 1-4 to make a total of 3 columns.

- 6. Place A3, RST with B3. (Fig 4)
- 7. Sew together and press seam.
- 8. Place A3, RST as shown in the diagram. (Fig 5)
- 9. Sew together and press seam. (Fig 6)






10.	Place A4, RST with B4.	(Fig 7)	Figure 7

15.	Sew together and press	seam.	B4 ←






MAKING THE COLUMNS - CONTINUED

- 16. Place A4, RST as shown in the diagram.
 (Fig 10)
- 17. Sew together and press seam. (Fig 11)
- 18. Repeat steps 10-17 for a total of 2 columns.



- 19. Place A4, RST with B2. (Fig 12)
- 20. Sew together and press seam.
- 21. Place A5, RST as shown in the diagram. (Fig 13)
- 22. Sew together and press seam.
- 23. Place B4, RST as shown in the diagram. (Fig 14))
- 24. Sew together and press seam.
- 25. Place A4, RST as shown in the diagram. (Fig 15)
- 26. Sew together and press seam. (Fig 16)






ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

21. Sew columns togethers as shown in diagram (Fig 17) Take your time to carefully pin and match the seams to line up the points.

22. Press all seams open.

FINISHING THE QUILT

- 23. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste and quilt using your method of choice.
- 24. Trim the back and batting to the same size as the quilt top to square up your layered quilt.
- 25. For binding, reference cutting chart and bind as desired.
- 26. Give yourself a pat on the back. You did it!
