LEISURE PORT COTTON CANVAS

Originally produced in 1969, the Leisure Port was prized by boaters camping on the wind swept beaches of Lake Powell due to its resilience in high winds and its generous shade in hot weather.

Re-imagined for the modern camper, the Leisure Port delivers shade and shelter for the beach, mountains, or backyard.



LEISURE PORT SET-UP GUIDE

Note* Leisure Port offers multiple set up configurations and variations. Once you get the basics down, let your creative spirit run with it.

1. Select a Site & Stake it Down.

Tip: Leisure Port MUST be securely staked down to function. In softor sandy soil, sand stakes or dead-man anchors may be required to achieve necessary hold.



2. Insert Ridge Poles and Spring Bars.

Use 2 ridge poles, 1 steel sleeve, and 4 spring bars.





3. Tension the Roof Panel.

Place the ridge poles end to end and press down to tension the roof. Slide the steel sleeve over the connection point to secure the ridge.



Tip: The tension screw may be adjusted to achieve more or less tension as needed.




4. Install One Upright Pole.

Tip: Assemble the upright pole on the shortest setting. After installing, lengthen the pole until the walls are taut-but not too tight.



5. Install Second Upright Pole.

Tip: Follow the same procedure outlined in Step 4.




6. Enjoy your Leisure Port.


Tip: Zip-In Panels can be added or removed as needed. The floor can also be removed if desired.

However, ALWAYS RE-INSTALL FLOOR before packing up the Leisure Port. The floor serves as a guide for correct stake placement.





Use tension straps & roll up one wall to create a 3-sided enclave.



Use tension straps and awning poles to create a super shade awning.
