

# PARTY BOWL™

3 ROUNDS. 2 TEAMS. 1 PARTY BOWL™.

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Contents:** • 1 Party Bowl™ • 1 Sand Timer  
• 200 Write-In Sheets • 6 Pencils  
• 90 Prompt Cards

### Setup:

Break into two even teams. If your group is an odd number, it's totally fine for one team to have an extra player.

If your team has three or fewer players, everyone grabs six prompt cards. If your team has four or more players, everyone grabs four prompt cards. For every prompt card, make sure you have one slip of paper.

Everyone should also grab a pencil. For each prompt card, write something on a different slip of paper (ex. if the prompt card says "An animal," you might write "Giraffe" on one of your slips of paper).

Once you've written your answers for each prompt card, fold them and put them in the Party Bowl™. The Party Bowl™ should now have every player's writing slips inside (combined from both teams).

### How to Play:

Decide which team goes first. If you can't decide on your own, whichever team has the player with the most Instagram® followers goes first. This game contains three rounds:

Round 1:

Round 2:

Round 3:

### Round 1: DESCRIBE



A player from Team A (the team going first) starts off the game by pulling slips of paper out of the Party Bowl™ one-by-one and trying to get their teammates to guess the answer. They can say anything they want to describe the answer, except what's written on the slip of paper of course. Ex. if the slip says "Giraffe" the player might say, "It's an animal with a really, really long neck!" This player has 60 seconds to get their teammates to guess as many answers as possible (use sand timer).

Once the timer runs out, Team B has a turn playing the exact same way. After 60 seconds, Team A goes again with a new player giving the clues, and so on and so forth until all of the slips of paper have been successfully guessed.

Count up the number of successfully guessed answers from each team and record them on the scorecard.  
Ex. if there are 40 slips total, Team A: 22, Team B: 18

## Round 2: 1 WORD



Whichever team has the lower score from Round 1 goes first this round. Place all the slips of paper back in the Party Bowl.<sup>TM</sup> Follow the same general gameplay as in Round 1, except instead of players giving unlimited clues, you can only say one word per slip as a clue!

Ex. if the slip says "Giraffe," the player might say "Neck!"

Once all slips have been guessed, count up the number of successfully guessed answers from each team and record them on the scorecard.

Ex. if there are 40 slips total, Team A: 15, Team B: 25

## Round 3: ACT IT OUT



Whichever team has the lower score combined from Round 1 + Round 2 goes first this round. Follow the same general gameplay as in Rounds 1 and 2, except instead of players giving verbal clues, you can only act out the clues! No talking whatsoever while giving clues!

Ex. if the slip says "Giraffe," the player might stick their neck out and walk around on all fours like a giraffe.

## A few friendly reminders:

Players are allowed to pass on a word they think is too difficult to guess and throw it back into the bowl. But keep in mind it might come back to your team later. Try to avoid writing verbs on the slips of paper. Nouns work best. Be creative when writing your answers!
