## HOW TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

Note: Print this ring size guide at $100 \%$ scale. Make sure that you print the guide on A4 paper ( $210 \mathrm{~mm} \times 297 \mathrm{~mm}$ ), otherwise you won't be able to determine your accurate ring size. To make sure you are printing the correct size, place a credit card on the area indicated at thr right top side. If the card fits, you have printed the correct size.

## OPTION 1

Measure your ring size: Take an existing ring and simply match the inside of the ring to one of the circles below. The circle that shows only the black circle and little to no white paper inside your ring will be your optimal ring size. If your optimal ring size lies somewhere between two sizes, opt for the larger size.

## OPTION 2

Measure your finger size: Cut out the following ruler and then cut the dotted line to create an opening. Wrap the ruler around your finger and lock it in place by inserting the triangular side in the opening. Once satisfied with the fit, move the ruler across your knucle. If the ruler slides on and off easily, read the number on the ruler as it indicates your optimal ring size. If not, adjust the ruler again to find your optimal ring size.


Please note that the ring size may vary slightly depending on the ring style.
