# **Consumer Limited Warranty: ONE-YEAR WARRANTY**

This warranty guarantees that the product purchased is to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal usage and local voltage for a period of one year. This warranty expires in TWO (2) years on parts, and ONE (1) year on labor after the date of purchase.

U.S. Jaclean, Inc. (referred to as "the Warrantor") will repair this product with new or rebuilt parts in case of defects in material or workmanship, free of charge, in the USA provided that:

- 1) The product is operated in accordance with the printed instructions supplied.
- 2) The product is used under normal conditions for which designed.
- 3) The product is not subjected to misuse, negligence, or accident.
- 4) The product receives proper care, protection, and maintenance.

This warranty is extended to the original end-user when purchased from an authorized U.S. Jaclean, Inc. distributor. A purchase receipt or other proof of date of the original purchase is required for service and parts replacement under this warranty. This warranty does not cover shipping charges for defective items if a claim is made more than 30 days after the date of purchase.



- 1. Be sure to unplug the unit when it is unattended. Ensure that it is left unplugged when not in use or before installing or removing any parts.
- 2. Children and any person requiring special care should use this unit under adult supervision.
- 3. Be sure to use this unit for the purposes described in this manual. Please do not install parts and accessories not provided by the manufacturer.
- 4. This unit must not be used under these conditions:
  - a) the power cord or plug is damaged;
  - b) the unit is malfunctioning or operating incorrectly;
  - c) the unit is damaged or exposed to water.

Contact our service center for inspection and repair.

- Do not move this massage chair by pulling the power cord or using the cord as a handle.

- Do not unplug or flip the power switch when the unit is in use.
- Do not move the unit while it is in use or while anyone is in it.

# PRODUCT STORAGE AND MAINTENANCE

#### CLEANING

- ▶ Before cleaning, switch OFF power and remove the power plug from the wall outlet.
- ▶ Dip a soft, cotton cloth in neutral detergent and wring dry. Use it to wipe the pillow cushion, back cushion, armrests, legrests, and any plastic parts of the chair.
- ▶ Use a piece of wet cloth (without detergent) to re-wipe the pillow cushion and back
- ▶ Use a soft, dry cloth to re-wipe the armrests, legrests, and any plastic parts of the chair.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the controller, and the power supply box.
- ▶ To clean the foot/calf unit covers, remove them from the chair, hand wash with mild detergent and hang dry.



# **A** CAUTION

- ▶ Before any maintenance, always disconnect the power plug from the wall outlet.
- ▶ To avoid electric shock, never touch the power plug with wet hands.
- ▶ When cleaning the back cover of the massage chair, do not allow any detergent to seep into the power supply box.
- ▶ Do not use abrasive chemicals, such as benzene or alcohol, to clean this chair. Damage to the chair may result.
- ▶ Do not apply an iron or any other heated device to the chair.

#### **STORAGE**

When not in use, be sure to switch off power and detach the power plug from the wall outlet. Before putting into storage, wipe off all accumulated dirt and dust from the surface of the chair. Cover the entire surface of the chair with a dust cover (not included).



## CAUTION

- ▶ Do not store the product under direct sunlight, nor in a location with high temperatures. Doing so may cause the upholstery to fade.
- ▶ Do not allow massage chair to remain in contact with vinyl or wallpaper for extended periods of time as this could lead to discoloration.

#### MAINTENANCE

Upon detecting any of the following conditions during daily use, immediately turn off power, disconnect the power plug from the wall outlet, and contact an authorized repairman:


- ► A burning smell
- ► The power cord feels hot
- ► Any other abnormal functioning
- ► The cord is plugged in and the power switch flipped on, but no functions operate

#### **GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS**

This unit must be grounded. If it should malfunction or breakdown, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

#### TURNING ON THE POWER

- ▶ Plug the power cord into the port at the base of the chair.
- ▶ Plug the three-pronged power plug into a properly grounded three-pronged power outlet.
- ► Flip on the power supply switch, located on the back of the massage chair at the base of the backrest.



# **■** SETUP

## MOVE METHOD

- ► Make sure that the backrest is in its highest upright position.
- ► Shut off power and remove the power plug from the wall outlet.
- ▶ Standing behind the back of the chair, grasp its backrest and tilt it downward, so that the front of the chair rises off of the floor. Push the chair to the location you desire.




# **CAUTION**

- ▶ Do not attempt to move the chair while someone is still sitting on it.
- ▶ When moving the chair, always grasp it by the backrest. Do not move the chair by pulling its armrests, as the armrests can dislodge.
- ▶ Before plugging it in, inspect the entire power cord and plug for any possible damage. Make sure that no electrical wires are exposed.
- ▶ Make sure that the power supply switch is turned OFF before inserting the power plug into a wall outlet.


#### BEFORE USING THE MASSAGE CHAIR FOR THE FIRST TIME

- ▶ Make sure there are no objects, people, or pets in the vicinity of the unit.
- ▶ Check that the chair has room to recline. Allow at least 24 in. of open space infront of the legrest and 4 in. behind the backrest.
- ▶ Use the controller to lower the backrest to its furthest outstretched position.
- ▶ Raise the legrest to its highest position. Make sure that the legrest is properly connected to the chair.
- ▶ Press the power button to return the chair to its original, upright position.




# MASSAGE CHAIR PLACEMENT

- ► Ensure adequate space to recline.
- ▶ Do not expose the massage lounger to direct sunlight or high temperatures, such as infront of heating sources because this can cause discoloration or hardening of the synthetic leather.
- ▶ Place the unit on a mat to pevent floor damage.
- ► Install the unit near a power socket.
- ▶ Be sure to place the chair within 4ft of a power plug.

#### ARMREST CONTROLLER



#### ARMREST CONTROLLER OPERATION

The Armrest Controller gives you the convenient access to key functions of your chair. Please use the Main Controller for full access to all of the chair's functions (see page 8).



# Power/Auto Massage Button

- ▶ When massage chair is in sleep mode, long press this button for 3 seconds to power on the chair (white indicator surrounding the button lights up).
- Press again to start Auto Massage Program, you may toggle among 6 pre-set Auto Massage programs.
- ▶ Long press this button again to turn off the massage chair.



# Rotary Switch

Use the button and rotary switch to achieve quick controls:

- ► Press the Heat button on the armrest (red indicator lights up), then rotate the rotary switch to adjust the heat settings.
- Press the Prompt Voice button on the armrest (red indicator lights up), then rotate the rotary switch to adjust the Prompt Voice volumes.
- ▶ Press the 4D Massage button on the armrest (red indicator lights up), then rotate the rotary switch to adjust the 4D Massage strength.
- Press the Air Pressure Massage button on the armrest (red indicator lights up), then rotate the rotary switch to adjust the Air Pressure Massage intensity.
- ▶ Press the Footrest Extension Adjust button on the armrest (red indicator lights up), then rotate the rotary switch to adjust the Footrest Extension.
- ▶ Press the Footrest Up/Down button on the armrest (red indicator lights up), then rotate the rotary switch to adjust the footrest position.
- Press the Back Up/Down button on the armrest (red indicator lights up), then rotate the rotary switch to adjust the backrest position.

Tip: Always press the quick control button first (the red indicator will light up when the function is activated) then rotate the rotary switch to adjust the settings.



# Zero Gravity Position Button

▶ Press to put the chair in Zero Gravity, the indicator light will turn red; press again to turn off the function, the indicator light will turn green.



#### Pause/Resume Button


▶ Press to pause the massage chair function, press again to resume the massage.

# SETUP

#### How to Use the Mobile Phone Holder


- ▶ When connected to power, the red and green indicator light will illuminate.
- After 3-5 seconds, press the Release Button or Bottom Grip to activate.
- ► Touch the button again to slide open the left and right arms of the cradle.






### **STEP 6: Power Supply**

- ► Connect the controller to the corresponding port on the power supply box. Insert the power plug of the chair into a wall outlet, then turn on power to return the chair's backrest to its upright position.
- ▶ After all parts assembled, insert the power cord into the power socket, and then turn on the switch, press the power on the remote control to start massage.




#### STEP 4: Install the Controller Unit

► Connect the Control Cable Plug Connector to the massage chair's Controller Cable Port, then tighten the screw cap clockwise to secure the connector in place. (Check below illustration for reference.)



#### **STEP 5: Install Mobile Phone Holder**

- ▶ Remove the Mobile Phone Holder parts from their carton.
- ▶ Connect the Clamp Arm Power Cord to the Cradle Charging Port.
- ▶ Unscrew the Top Locknut and slide it over the knob of the Clamp Arm. Insert the Ball Joint into the Holder Cradle port and screw the Top Locknut unit it is secure.
- ▶ Insert the Lower End of the Clamp Arm into the socket on the chair. Turn the Bottom Locknut clockwise to secure the Mobile Phone Holder into place.



# MASSAGE CHAIR OPERATION



## Heat Button

▶ Press to turn on Back Heat, the button indicator turns red; press again to turn off back heat, the button indicator turns green.



### Prompt Voice Button

► Press to turn on Prompt Voice, the button indicator turns red; press again to turn off the function, the button indicator turns green.



# 4D Massage Button

Press to turn on the 4D massage, the button indicator turns red; press again to turn off 4D massage, the button indicator turns green.



# Air Pressure Massage Button

► Press this button to turn on the Air Pressure Massage, the button indicator turns red; press again to turn it off, the button indicator turns green.



# Footrest Extension Adjustment Button

Press to turn on the Footrest Extension adjust, the indicator turns red; press again to turn off footrest extension adjust function, the button indicator turns green.



## Feet Up/Down Button

Press to turn on Footrest Up/Down adjust, the button indicator turns red; press again to turn off Footrest Up/Down adjust, the indicator light turns green.



# Back Up/Down Button


Press this button to turn on backrest up/down adjust, the button indicator turns red; press again to turn off Backrest up/down adjust, the indicator light turns green.




## **WARNING**


## MAIN CONTROLLER



▶ After attaching the legrest, lock Connecting Rods into place by sliding one of the included Locks over the edge of the rod and pressing down until it clicks.




▶ Raise the legrest unit, thread the Airtube into the Air Valve, and plug the Legrest Electrical Plug into the Legrest Electrical Port, make sure they are well secured. (Check below illustration for reference.)



### STEP 3: Installing the Legrest

- ► Lift the Legrest Unit Hook and connect it to the Chair Coupling Shaft by hanging it (pay attention to the balance), move the hook to one side of the Chair Coupling Shaft.
- ► Then attach the other side.

#### MAIN CONTROLLER OPERATION



## Power Button

- ▶ Press to turn ON the unit. The display screen will light up.
- ▶ Press again to turn OFF all functions and power down.
- ▶ Press twice to return the chair to its original upright position.



#### Menu Button

▶ During any massage operation, press here to select a massage function or to start or stop a feature during your current massage program.



# Point Adjustment Buttons

- ▶ Press to move the position of the rollers up and down the back.
- ▶ Use the up and down buttons to adjust the rollers to your desired position.



### Auto Mode Button

▶ Press to access the chair's Automatic Massage Programs.



#### Direction Dial

- ▶ After pressing the Menu or Auto Program buttons use the Up, Down, Left, or Right keys to navigate the screen. Then press the OK key to confirm a selection.
- ▶ During a massage, press the Up or Down direction keys to adjust the massage speed.
- ▶ Use the Left and Right direction keys to adjust the airbag force.



# Legrest Up Button

- ▶ Press and hold to raise the legrest.
- ▶ Release when it reaches your desired position.



# Legrest Down Button

- ▶ Press and hold to lower the legrest.
- ▶ Release when it reaches your desired position.



# 4D Protruding Intensity

► While the Manual massage program is running, press to change the 4D protruding intensity.



# Backrest Up Button

- ▶ Press and hold to raise the Backrest.
- ▶ Release when it reaches your desired position.



## Backrest Down Button

- Press and hold to lower the Backrest.
- ► Release when it reaches your desired position.



# Extend Legrest Button

- ▶ Press and hold to extend the Legrest.
- ▶ Release when it reaches your desired position.



### Retract Legrest Button

- ▶ Press and hold to retract the Legrest if your legs need more room.
- ▶ Release when it reaches your desired position.

#### MASSAGE MODES

This chair includes Automatic Massage and Manual Massage Modes. Automatic Massages are timed and pre-programmed routines that use all of the features of your chair for a tailored experience that you can enjoy with the touch of a button. Or you can choose the features you want and where you want to target by selecting Manual Mode and customizing each of the chair's many functions one at a time. The descriptions below help you navigate the interface for both Automatic and Manual Massage Modes.

#### AUTOMATIC PROGRAMS

- ▶ Press followed by to bring up the Automatic Programs menu.
- ▶ Use the up and down arrow keys to navigate the 12 Auto Massage Programs: Chair Yoga, Gentle Yoga, Power Yoga, Royal Treatment, Stress Relief, Gentle Care, Neck & Shoulder, Back & Spine, Waist & Hip, Morning Buzz, Refreshing Nap, and Sweet Dreams.




## INSTALLATION METHOD


### STEP 1: Unpack All Parts

- ► Carefully lift the chair and all of its parts from packaging.
- ▶ Remove any protective wrapping and check to make sure that all parts are present.
- ▶ Before beginning installation, please verify all components are included.

#### Step 2: Install the Armrests

- ► Connect the numbered Air Hoses on the chair to the matching numbered Air Nozzles on the armrest (illustration 1)
- ▶ Attach the Armrest to the seat using the Arm Hook. Line the armrest up with the backrest then press the armrest to connect in place (illustration 2).
- ▶ Once together tighten the screw to secure the armrest into place (illustration 3).
- ▶ Repeat the same installation method used for the other side.

### Royal Treatment

Designed to greet you after a long work day, this program helps to rejuvenate you both physically and emotionally.

#### Stress Relief

▶ Designed to help to ease pain and stiffness in the neck and shoulders combined with the curvature design of the backrest, this program targets rollers at the deep tissue muscles of the neck and shoulders.

#### Gentle Care

Focusing the massage on the lumbar vertebra, this program helps to soothe tension and keep the vitality of muscles.

#### Neck & Shoulder

► Combination of deep tissue massage techniques, this program focuses on muscles in the neck, shoulders, and upper back.

## Back & Spine

▶ Combination of deep tissue massage techniques, this program focuses on muscles along the spine, upper and lower back and lumbar.

# Waist & Hip



# Sliding-Reclining Linkage Mechanism

► The chair slides forward and reclines to save space and provide the utmost relaxing position.



## Zero Gravity Position

► A weightless position that the height of the legs are slightly higher than the upper body, the weight of body can evenly distributed throughout, reducing the pressure of the spine and joints both physically and mentally.

# Human Hand Quad Style Massage Rollers

► Innovative human hand quad style massage rollers and L-shaped guiding track conform to ergonomic principle.

# Auto/Manual legrest Extension

► The Footrest can extend automatically to customize the user's leg length, you may also use the controller button to adjust the footrest according to your needs. The footrest can extend 7 in. automatically for various users of different height ranges.

# Air Pressure Massage

▶ Whole body air pressure massage for shoulders, arms, back, waist, hips, legs, and feet.

# Roller Massage for the Feet

▶ 3 underfoot rollers provide all-direction massage for the reflex zone.





#### Bluetooth

- ▶ Select BLUETOOTH from the SETTINGS then press the RIGHT button.
- ▶ Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to turn the bluetooth ON or OFF.
- ▶ Press OK to enter your desired settings.

# Charging

- ▶ Select CHARGING from the SETTINGS then press the RIGHT button.
- ▶ Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to turn the charging ON or OFF.
- ▶ Press OK to enter your desired settings.

Note: All Settings listed above will be memorized when you turn off the massage chair.

### Tips:

- ▶ In the process of Automatic or Manual Settings the LCD screen will auto revert back to the homescreen after 10 seconds if there is no operation entered.
- ▶ While unit is running, press the MENU button twice to revert to homescreen.
- ▶ At the homescreen display, use the LEFT or RIGHT buttons to adjust the airbag intensity (works in the process of both Auto and Manual program); press UP or DOWN to adjust the massage intensity (only works in the process of Manual program).



Homescreen display with the Manual program running




Homescreen display with the Auto program running

# MASSAGE CHAIR OPERATION




#### Width

- ▶ Select WIDTH from the MANUAL display then press the RIGHT arrow key.
- ▶ Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to navigate the roller widths.
- Press the OK button to select your desired roller width. The options are Wide, Medium, or Narrow.

### Speed

- ▶ Select SPEED from the MANUAL display then press the RIGHT arrow key.
- ▶ Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to navigate the speed intensity.
- ▶ Press the OK button to select your desired speed.




### Foot Roller Speed

- ▶ Select ROLLER from the MANUAL display then press the RIGHT arrow key.
- ▶ Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to navigate the foot roller speeds.
- ▶ Press the OK button to select your desired speed. The options are 1, 2, 3 or OFF.


## Zero Gravity

- ▶ Select ZERO from the MANUAL display then press the RIGHT arrow key.
- ▶ Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to turn the function ON or OFF.
- ▶ Press the OK button to make a selection.



# 4D Massage

- ▶ Select 4D MASSAGE from the MENU display then press the RIGHT arrow key.
- ▶ Press the OK button to enter the FORCE options.
- ▶ Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to navigate the protruding intensity.
- ▶ Press the OK button to select your desired intensity.



# Airbag

- ▶ Select AIRBAG from the MENU display then press the OK button.
- ▶ Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to choose your desired PART and FORCE.


#### Part

- ▶ Select PART from the AIRBAG display then press the RIGHT arrow key.
- ► Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to choose your target area. The options are Full, Arm & Shoulder, Back & Waist, Leg & Foot, and Buttock.
- Press the OK button to select the airbag position you desire.

#### Force


- ▶ Select FORCE from the AIRBAG display then press the RIGHT arrow key.
- ► Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to navigate force levels. The options are 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or OFF.
- Press the OK button to make a selection.

#### Back Heat

- ▶ Select HEAT from the MENU display then press the RIGHT arrow key.
- ▶ Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to navigate heat intensity. The options are 1, 2, 3, or OFF.
- ▶ Press the OK button to delect desired back heat level.



## Settings

- ▶ Select SETTINGS from the MENU display then press the OK button.
- ► Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to navigate the setting options. Settings available are Time, Language, Bluetooth, and Charging.
- ▶ Press OK to make a selection.

# Massage Time

- ▶ Select TIME from the SETTINGS then press the RIGHT button.
- ▶ Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to navigate the time options. Time options are 10 min, 20 min, or 30 minutes.
- Press OK to select desired time.

## Language

- ▶ Select LANGUAGE from the SETTINGS then press the RIGHT button.
- ► Use the UP and DOWN arrow keys to navigate languages. Available languages are Chinese or English.
- ▶ Press OK to select desired language.
