Introduction

Proaim Sky-Dweller Jib is the most advanced version of Proaim Jibs & Cranes. It is designed to offer benefits of a rideable jib in smaller studios, or on locations. The versatile and durable high-grade Aluminum constructed 10ft/3mtr long jib can carry up to 200kg/440lb and offers movement up to 8.5ft height. The platform offers space on the Turnstile Mount to fit two Seat Arms with Round Seats and a Euro Mount for mounting Bazooka, Camera Height Riser, etc. Sky-Dweller includes Marshal Dolly with Centre Column which is a solid chassis (fixed width) Dolly, able to carry larger payloads up to 1000Kg/1Ton.

Safety Hints

ATTENTION: PLEASE READ THIS BEFORE USING TO PREVENT DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT & OPERATOR

- The jib may not be assembled or operated under influence of alcohol, drugs or any other intoxicating substances. Lack of attention while connecting the components together can cause substantial damage to equipment/operator.
- The jib may only be operated on levelled horizontal position. Make sure that the surface is stable.
- Personnel on board the crane's platform must use Safety Belts.
- The complete panning & lifting range around it must be kept free. No loose objects may be stored or placed on it. Be careful while using indoors.
- Never operate the jib in immediate vicinity of high-voltage power cables. It holds danger to life.

- When you want to transport the crane, lock the Pan & Tilt Axis for safety. Make sure that the components do not rub together and cause any material wear.
- In the interest of safe crane operation, avoid abruptly swivelling or stopping the crane, otherwise it may cause damage to equipment. Crane operators must be trained in this regard and may only be performed in a safe swivel range crane movements.
- Before counterweights are removed, ensure the platform is resting on ground or supported by any stable underlay. Then gradually remove the counterweights before personnel leave the platform.
- The crane operating on a vehicle is strictly prohibited! The manufacturer makes no warranty and liability when using the crane out on a vehicle.

Assembling the Jib Crane

NOTE: You can mount Sky-Dweller Jib on any Euro-base compatible Stand and Dolly. We have shown it positioned on our Proaim Marshall Dolly with Proaim Centre Column.

 Place Sky-Dweller Jib onto the Euro-adapter of Centre Column.



• Fix the Jib fork with Centre Column by locking the knob and also by locking lever for maximum tightening.






 Lock the allen bolt on Column accurately, for dual safety of Jib.



 Attach provided Jib Section by sliding its mount into the Main Hub Section.



Remove Locking Pin from one side of Counterweight Rod, insert it through Counterweight
Basket and mount both on Jib Section. Then lock the Rod with knob to secure its position on
Basket.





Now install Connection Rod with Main Hub Section. Pull knob and press it firmly with top rod
of Hub Section to position it.





• Similarly, position other end of Connection Rod with Counterweight Basket.






 Then insert rest of two Counterweight Rods into Basket and secure their position with locking knobs.





 Now position Turnstile Mount with Platform directly with Jib and tighten both the knob & locking lever to fix it appropriately.

NOTE: You can have 2-Stage Setup Versions, to raise or lower the height of Platform, as desired.






 Attach High-Low Rig with Jib mounting. Tighten both the knob & locking lever to fix it appropriately.

NOTE: Here you can have 4-Stage Setup Versions, to achieve close to the ground or high shots, as per the requirement. The High-Low Rig can also be fixed in upside-down positions.





• Now affix Turnstile Mount with Platform with High-Low Rig, at any desired position. Tighten both the knob & locking lever to secure it accurately.






Note: If you have purchased (JB-SKDW-02) kit, consider the following steps:

Assembling the Dolly

To avoid unwanted accident while assembling the crane, please assemble the dolly with supporting feet. It also increases the stability.

• Insert Levelling Support Feet on all 4 corners of Marshal Dolly. Secure them with a ring.





 Insert Lever onto Levelling Support to adjust the length of feet from ground. Then lock the Support with knob.





 Loosen and remove Wheel Support in order to mount the Wheel onto Dolly.



• Insert Wheel into its appropriate space on Dolly and tighten back the Wheel Support to secure it.





• Tighten to apply the Front Wheel Brakes while assembling to ensure double security.





 Insert Steering Push/Pull Bar into Dolly's Rear-axle. Lock with knob to secure the Steering accurately.





Attaching the Centre Column

• Loosen all 4 screws on the center of Dolly. Place lower section of Centre Column onto it.





• Twist the Column to align all its corners with screws. Tighten them back to secure it.





 Now place upper section of Centre Column onto the lower section. Twist to align all its corners with screws and tighten them properly to secure it.





• The Marshal Dolly with Centre Column will look as shown in image.

NOTE: To decrease the height of your Jib from floor, you can remove lower section of Column and fix upper section directly onto the center of Dolly.



Balancing Tips

NOTE: The required weights are mentioned to balance the Jib arm only, without Camera setup.

- Self-Balancing Weight: 1kg / 2.2lb
- For an average person of 70kg / 154lb, weights required for balancing: 60kg / 132lb
