

OLEFIN

- Olefin is developed out of thermoplastic polymers.
- It is the second strongest fiber with the lightest weight.
- The fibers have low moisture absorption, but they can wick moisture and dry quickly and is therefore a desirable choice for lightweight athleisure garments.

PROPERTIES:

- Lightweight.
- Strong.
- Does not absorb any perspiration.
- Holds oil stains.
- Draws moisture away from the body.
- Can build up static.
- Pilling.
- Does not have a high heat tolerance.
- Resistant to abrasion + chemicals.

CARE:

- Machine washable.
- Wash on normal cycle with warm water.
- Machine dry low - use fabric softener to reduce static build-up.
- Always check for stains before drying, as stains will set in with the heat of the dryer.
- Press on low on the inside of the fabric to prevent melting.
