

RAMIE

- Although Ramie was used in prehistoric China, Europe, and Egypt, this plant fiber was not commonly used until the past decade due to its difficulty in processing.
- Stronger and more absorbent than flax and cotton, it takes dye better and is quick drying.
- The fiber has a slightly lustrous appearance that improves with washing, + it shrinks less than other cellulose fibers.

PROPERTIES:

- Breathable.
- Absorbs perspiration quickly without feeling damp to the skin.
- Does not stretch or pill.
- Wrinkles easily.
- Softens over time.
- Does not build up static.
- High heat tolerance.

CARE:

- Machine washable.
- Wash on gentle cycle with cold water. Tumble dry low.
- Ramie garments are typically designed to be air-dried + worn without ironing. Options are as follows:
 - Leave unpressed for a natural look.
 - Remove from dryer while still damp + hang to dry.
 - Press on medium-high heat while slightly damp to remove wrinkles.
