eeping grass areas trim and ordered produces grass cuttings. For years most of us have collected grass cuttings and disposed of them in green bins or compost heaps.

A typical half acre lawn produces more than 4 tons of grass clippings in a single season. A traditional mower will either collect these clippings, or discharge them as it mows.

The recent introduction of mulching mowers is changing that. So what is a

mulching mower and what are its benefits?

Mechanically a mulching mower is similar to any

equivalent cut and collect mower, except for its deck design and cutting blades. The deck has no discharge ports and the cutting blades are aerodynamic, producing a powerful downdraught as they cut.

Mowing with a mulch mower is different, its multi-cutting deck retains clippings within the deck where they are cut and recut into small particles. These are blown down into the turf where they decompose. The result is a lawn that looks great and no clippings to collect.

Disposing of clippings in this eco-friendly way, returns valuable nutrients to the soil reducing the need for chemical fertilisers. Our half acre lawn for example, will benefit from the 100 pounds of nitrogen and other valuable trace elements contained in its 4 tons of clippings.

Mulch mowing is quicker too! Mowing time is significantly reduced compared

with cut and collect systems as you don't stop to dispose of grass clippings.





Summer Control of Docks, Nettles and Thistles in Grassland

ecent weather has been welcome in many ways, but may have also been a hindrance to weed control in grassland. Docks, Nettles and Thistles will be approaching or already at the growth stage of flowering or seed set. Regardless of any potential chemical weed control plans, if they are at this latter stage they should ideally be topped to stop seeding.

Just a 10% infestation of Docks or Thistles can cause a 10% loss in yield, reduced quality in silage and hay and in the case of thistles, they can spread Orf, so there is real value in controlling the major grassland weeds.

The decision to spot treat (using a knapsack sprayer or a lance on a quad bike mounted sprayer) or to treat overall using a boom sprayer (tractor or quad bike mounted) can be made based on the weed population present. For weed infestations up to 5%, a spot treatment is most appropriate. Over 5%, it is normally economically viable to make an overall treatment. The best herbicides to choose are those which are translocated and which kill down to the roots. Grazon®Pro, for Spot Treatment, or Thistlex®, Doxstar®Pro and Pas®.Tor® from Corteva Agriscience, for overall treatment, would be the main products used to control these weeds.

As with the more usual spring and autumn applications of these products, the weeds need to be actively growing, they should be at the appropriate growth stage for spraying which is normally achieved 2-3 weeks after topping and the grass crop must also be growing actively and be free of stress e.g. lack of moisture / too much moisture or other issues.

Docks

Docks, a perennial plant, are prolific seed producers. A broadleaved dock can produce 60,000 seeds, whilst a curled dock can produce 40,000 seeds. These seeds can potentially remain viable in the soil for 80 years.

Best control of docks will be achieved in good growing conditions when they are actively growing and nutrients are being transported to new foliage and roots. If seed stalks are seen on the plant if the dock has diseased leaves or is under pest attack, it is better to top and allow re-growth of the docks before applying chemical.

At the time of spraying, docks should ideally be the size of an 8" (20cm) dinner plate. This means that there is enough leaf surface area to take up sufficient chemical which can then move throughout the plant and, importantly, into the large taproot to kill it. Doxstar Pro should be applied at a rate of 2L/ha in 300 to 400 litres of water, unless low drift nozzles are used, when water rates can be reduced to 200L/ha.

Common Nettle

Common Nettle, also a perennial, are generally found in clumps, favouring areas of high soil fertility and they propagate mainly from extensive creeping root stolons. New plants develop from root sections, so chopping them up does no more than multiply the problem. They will grow up to a height of 1 metre, eventually forming dense beds, which spread out across the field. Germination occurs if the soil is disturbed or the sward open. This can be the result of over-grazing in early spring and open swards caused by poaching.

Common nettle is best controlled when young and actively growing at 15-25cm high. Non-chemical control can include cutting clumps prior to flowering up-to three times per year over successive years.

Infestations tend to be in clumps, so if caught in time, spot treatment with a herbicide usually suffices, but treatment needs to take place when there is active weed growth and before a canopy begins to form as this can reduce the amount of chemical that can land on the leaves of the plant and then be translocated into the extensive root system. Established common nettle will normally require regular treatment.

Choose a translocated herbicide that kills down to the roots such as Grazon Pro for spot treatment or Pas-Tor for overall treatment.

The rate of use is 60ml Grazon Pro per 10L water.

Pas-Tor is supplied in an Agronomy Pack and should be applied at a rate of 2L/ha (1L/ha Pas + 1L/ha Tor) in 300 to 400 litres of water, unless low drift nozzles are used, when water rates can be reduced to 200L/ha.

If treating Thistles and some nettles are present, Thistlex has a useful effect on common nettle as well as giving excellent control of the thistles.

Thistles (Creeping and Spear)

Creeping Thistle, another perennial plant, grows mainly from an underground stem, or rhizome, and this can make total control difficult with one spray. In the first year of growth, creeping thistle roots can cover 5 sqm and in the second year up to 80 sqm. A creeping thistle can produce up to 40,000 seeds with these potentially remaining viable for 10-21 years. Significant yield losses are caused by creeping thistle and they also cause significant loss of grazing land by preventing animals grazing around them. This can equate to 0.5m2 per thistle! Frequent topping is unlikely to reduce the population of creeping thistle and can even stimulate the growth of significantly more plants from the extensive root network. This can be advantageous though, as there will be a significantly increased area of leaf to treat with a translocated herbicide, which will result in more chemical being taken down to the roots.

Spear thistle is a biennial plant which only spreads by seed. Each plant lives for 2 years producing a flat rosette of leaves in year one and then the familiar 'tree-like' structure in year two. Once controlled in the re-seed, it is rarely a problem in



grazed fields except after poaching or other sward damage. Topping is not effective to control the growth in year one of their lifecycle (as the thistles are likely to be growing under the mower cutting level), but can be carried out on the second-year growth before seed is set.

Best control of both creeping and spear thistle will be achieved when they are actively growing and before flowering. Thistlex gives excellent control of both and is best sprayed at 1L/ha in 200L/ha water. Sometimes thistle growth can be very uneven and it might be better to top the weeds and give them 2 - 3 weeks to regrow prior to treatment. If thistles are already flowering, this is also the best option. Because of the nature of thistle growth, a second treatment later in the season may be required to control any late shooting plants.

Docks, Nettles and Thistles combined in a single field

Where there is a combination of weeds such as docks, nettles and thistles the Pas-Tor Agronomy Pack offers an option for overall treatment. It gives excellent control of a wide range of weeds in silage, hay and grazing fields.

The importance of using the correct water volumes in overall treatments

Water volumes are critical to achieving good coverage of the weeds and, therefore, good levels of long-term control. Consequently, water volumes should not be cut below the minimum volumes stated on the product label.

Spot treatment of lower weed populations

If spot spraying, be careful to give the leaves a good coverage, but do not spray them to the point of run-off. This is when the small spray droplets touch one another and form larger droplets which then run off the leaf onto the floor.

Grazon Pro offers a very cost-effective way of controlling weeds when applying through

a knapsack. It has an extremely wide weed spectrum and will tackle most tough weeds such as Docks, Nettles and Thistles, but also weeds such as bramble, broom, gorse and other significant invasive weeds. The rate of use is 60ml Grazon Pro per 10L water.

Grazing and Cutting Intervals

When a Corteva Agriscience product has been used for control of weeds in grassland, it is important to keep stock out of the treated field for just 7-days or if the grass is going to be cut, an interval of 28 days is required. This will ensure that sufficient chemical has moved down to the roots for long-term control.

Planning weed control for re-seeding

Cultivation of un-controlled dock, nettle and creeping thistle roots can add significantly to the weed problem that will also be present in the new crop following germination of weed seeds in the weed seed bank in the soil. The un-controlled root fragments will grow more vigorously than the weed seeds germinating in the seed bank and could become too large to be controlled effectively by the time that the new crop can be treated with herbicide. Getting weed control right in the current crop is always important and will also benefit future crops too. Payments to farmers in stewardship agreements are to be paid finally for the environmental work they have undertaken. Farmers and landowners who were in Countryside Stewardship



and Environmental Stewardship agreements still haven't received payment but will now do so after the Rural Payments Agency announced that the outstanding claims for agri environmental schemes will now be paid in full.

These payments will be paid in July to those farmers and landowners still owed and the Rural Payments Agency will write to everyone concerned in the next week to provide an update. The Rural Payments Agency are determined to keep a regular cycle of monthly payments and restore confidence in these valuable schemes.

Looking after the environment is important and something which needs to progress, but farmers and landowners need to feel that taking their land out of production to nurture the environment is worthwhile both to them and the wider cause.

The Environment Land Management scheme is due to replace the Countryside Stewardship and Environmental Stewardship schemes once Britain leaves the EU and The Environmental Land Management scheme will be subject to rigorous testing, research and analysis before being launched and is due to be in operation by 2024.

The Countryside Code

Tips on how to follow the countryside code

- 1. Keep dogs under close control but remember if a farm animal chases you, it's much safer to let your dog off the lead.
- 2. Stay informed on where and when you can walk in your area. Some areas of land are restricted if work is being carried out and during wildlife breeding seasons.
- 3. Leave gates as you find them and if you're in a group, make sure the last person knows how to leave the gate.
- 4. You should always stick to paths if possible but this is especially important in a field where crops are growing.
- 5. Use gates and stiles where possible, to avoid damaging fences and hedges.
- 6. Leave animals alone, especially if with their young. If an animal appears to be in distress, contract the farmer.
- 7. Litter isn't just dangerous to wildlife, dumping rubbish is a criminal offense.
- 8. By law, dogs must be on short leads in most areas of open country between March 1st and July 31st (to help protect nesting birds), and at all times near farm animals.
- 9. Farmers are entitled to destroy a dog that injures or worries their animals unless you completely trust your dog, keep it on a lead around livestock.
- 10. Clean up dog mess it can cause infections such as neosporosis. Make sure your dog is wormed regularly and take faeces back to the nearest bin – dog poo bags are a blemish on the countryside.
