PISTOL TACTICS 1 & 2 GEAR LIST

1. ****MANDATORY**** 1 – Good attitude – If you are overly sensitive or a “snowflake,” a Nine and One Tactical class is not for you!
2. ****MANDATORY**** 1 - Semi-automatic pistol, in serviceable caliber, i.e. 9mm or .45acp preferably. **NO REVOLVERS!**
1. ****MANDATORY**** MINIMUM 500 rounds of QUALITY, BRASS CASED ammunition. **NO RELOADED AMMUNITION WHATSOEVER! YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE RANGE WITH RELOADED AMMUNITION. THE COST OF THE CLASS WILL NOT BE REFUNDED IF YOU BRING CRAPPY AMMO. ALSO, NO ALUMINUM CASED AMMO. BRASS CASED, FACTORY LOADED AMMO ONLY, PLEASE.** **Any ammunition meeting the aforementioned specs will probably operate just fine but PLEASE, don't skimp on your ammo purchase. This will go a long way toward you having a good range experience. If it's the cheapest thing on the shelf, there's probably a reason. Also, buy from Ammo Supply Warehouse at www.ammosupplywarehouse.com, especially if you intend to buy in bulk. (500 - 1,000+ rounds at a time) Ammo Supply Warehouse has great prices and very fast, dependable customer service. **
2. ****MANDATORY**** 1 - Sturdy belt capable of supporting the weight of a pistol and spare magazines. "Superbio gun-belts" are HIGHLY recommended. They're some of the best gun-belts on the market. **NO PANTS WITHOUT BELT LOOPS! NO YOGA PANTS, OVERALLS, COVERALLS, ETC... YOU MUST WEAR A BELT AND HAVE A HOLSTER THAT WILL PROPERLY ATTACH TO A BELT!**
3. ****MANDATORY**** 1 - Sturdy, strong side or appendix carry, gun holster. Kydex is preferred, especially for inside the waistband holsters. **THE HOLSTER MUST NOT COLLAPSE WHEN THE PISTOL IS DRAWN. IF YOU CANNOT REHOLSTER YOUR GUN WITH ONE HAND BECAUSE OF YOUR HOLSTER, THAT HOLSTER IS NOT WELCOME ON THE RANGE AND YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ONTO THE FIRING LINE. NO CROSS DRAW OR SHOULDER HOLSTERS ALLOWED AND NO "SMALL OF THE BACK" CARRY. THE PRICE OF THE CLASS WILL NOT BE REFUNDED IF YOU BRING A CRAPPY HOLSTER. THIS IS A SAFETY ISSUE!** At Nine and One Tactical, "NSR Tactical" holsters from www.NSRtactical.com are the preferred choice. **If NSR doesn't make a holster to fit your particular gun, you should absolutely reevaluate your gun selection. **
4. ****MANDATORY**** MINIMUM of three magazines for your pistol. Minimum of FOUR if your magazines hold less than 10 rounds of ammo.
5. ****STRONGLY RECOMMENDED**** 1 – Support side magazine pouch. You will be allowed to carry spare mags in your pocket while on the range but it's not recommended.

6. ****MANDATORY**** 1 – Set of ear protection. Electronic ear pro is recommended but not necessary.
7. ****MANDATORY**** 1 – Set of eye protection. Clear lenses are **MANDATORY** for the night portion of Pistol Tactics-2.
8. ****MANDATORY**** 1 – handheld flashlight capable of producing a minimum of 300 lumens. (Only required for Pistol Tactics 2)
9. ****RECOMMENDED**** Food and hydration while at the range. Water is recommended and will be provided for you in most situations. You'll need plenty of it, especially if it's hot. Food will not be provided unless otherwise specified at the time you sign up for class and we do not leave the range for lunch.
10. ****OPTIONAL**** 1 – Roll of 1" masking tape (white or tan)
11. ****OPTIONAL**** Basic gun cleaning supplies
12. ****OPTIONAL**** Knee pads
13. ****DUH**** Comfortable clothing, appropriate for the weather. Something you don't mind getting dirty. **LOW CUT SHIRTS ARE A BAD IDEA. SHIRTS SHOULD HAVE COLLARS THAT EITHER LAY FLAT OR CAN BE BUTTONED TO THE TOP.** T-shirts are perfectly acceptable.
14. ****OPTIONAL**** Rain gear. **WE DON'T CANCEL CLASS BECAUSE OF RAIN. WE WILL SHOOT IN THE RAIN UNLESS IT'S A TORRENTIAL DOWNPOUR OR SEVERE STORM.**
15. ****RECOMMENDED**** 1 – Hat. Ball-caps are preferred.
16. ****OPTIONAL**** Bug spray
17. ****OPTIONAL**** Sunscreen – weather dependent

NO DRUGS OF ANY KIND OR ALCOHOL AT THE RANGE WHATSOEVER! IF WE SEE IT, SMELL IT OR HEAR ABOUT YOU HAVING IT, YOU WILL BE IMMEDIATELY REMOVED FROM CLASS! (Potential life-saving medications such as nitroglycerin tablets or an epi-pen are the only exceptions)

Note: A few pairs of extra eye and ear protection will be available if you cannot provide your own and we will be glad to share those with anyone who needs them at the range. We also have a few extra holsters, magazine pouches and belts for those of you who may not have a quality gear of your own. We even have guns to loan out for class at no additional charge. If you need to use a loaner gun, you still have to provide ammo. Loaner guns are all 9mm and the ammo you bring should meet the aforementioned specifications. If you need to use any "loaner gear" LET ME KNOW WHEN YOU REGISTER FOR CLASS, to ensure that particular item will be reserved for you!

Also, have your gear ready to go before class and test everything you can BEFORE you arrive. This means, your magazines loaded, your ammo in some container other than the cardboard boxes it came in (preferably an ammo can), if any of your gear takes batteries (ear protection for example) make sure you have working batteries in the device(s) before you arrive, make sure the screws are tight on your holster or other support gear, and that everything you bring is sized for you. Please don't waste your time, my time or the time of your classmates by arriving unprepared. That'll only piss off everyone around you. You're an adult and we expect you to behave as such.
