



## CARE INSTRUCTIONS - TOWELLING

### WASHING

- ☒ For best results, wash towels at no more than 40°.
- ☒ Wash and dry your towels before using them for the first time. Washing the towels first will remove any manufacturing finishes and allows maximum absorbency.
- ☒ Avoid using fabric softeners on towelling, as it will reduce the absorbency of the fibre.
- ☒ Give your towels a shake when taking them out of the washer. This will help fluff the terry loops that aid absorbency.
- ☒ Use regular washing detergents and never use bleach.
- ☒ Do not wash your terry towelling products together with garments which have hooks or zips to prevent pull threads.

### DRYING

Line dry or tumble dry using a low heat setting only.

While tumble-drying will make the towel fluffy, do not overdo the drying, as the heat from the dryer can damage the integrity of the cotton fibre.

### PULLED THREADS

Our towels are of woven construction. If you catch the towel and pull a loop, cut off the pulled loop with a pair of scissors, a pulled loop will not unravel the towel. Trimming off pulled threads will avoid further damage and will not affect the softness or durability of the towel. For bathrobes, take care with hairbrushes/combs easily pull threads, especially around the collar area.

Care instructions especially for bath mats:

- ☒ Gentle or delicate machine cold-wash only.
- ☒ Do not dry-clean.
- ☒ Do not tumble-dry.
- ☒ Gentle spin cycle only.
- ☒ Do not use bleach or brightening agents.
