

CARE GUIDE FOR LACQUERED/PAINTED VENEER

DAILY CLEANING

Wipe with a clean, dry cloth or with a cloth or chamois that has been wrung out in clean water. If a wrung-out cloth is used, immediately wipe away the water with a clean, dry one.

Dirty surfaces are wiped with a cloth or chamois that has been wrung out hard in soapy water. Again, dry immediately with a clean, dry cloth.

THOROUGH CLEANING

We recommend using mild detergents for cleaning lacquered veneer, and there are a number of different products available on the market. Note that it is not recommended to use harsh detergents or products that contain scouring powder, as this will result in a dull, scratched and damaged surface.

NOTE!

Avoid exposing the surfaces to water or other liquids for an extended period of time. Spilled liquids should be wiped away immediately.
