

Sauvignon Blanc 2021

Frankland River Western Australia

COLOUR

Bright pale straw with a green hue.

Lifted aromas of ripe citrus, passionfruit, guava and subtle lemon grass

Juicy and pure mouthfeel displaying ripe lime, passionfruit and gooseberry flavours. Subtle texture and mouth-watering acidity to finish.

WINEMAKING

Machine harvested in the cool hours of the night over several picking dates. It was gently pressed, and the juice cold settled. Cool fermentation between 12-15oC in stainless steel. Racked off yeast lees, blended and filtered before bottling in July.

Fresh pan seared scallops and chorizo served with a squeeze of lemon and sprinkling of
