## Shiraz 2022

## Frankland River Western Australia

COLOUR

Brilliant deep purple with a lighter violet hue

Delicate aromas of blackberry, spiced plum, dark chocolate, and savoury notes.

PALATE

Elegant tannins and a red currant acidity ensure a long, savoury finish.

#### WINEMAKING

A combination of picks from estate-grown Block 8 and Block 9, a small portion of Block 3 and one other Great Southern site fermented separately. Destemmed whilst retaining as much whole berry as possible. Cold soaked, plunged and pumped over through the peak of fermentation. Pressed to older barriques, hogsheads and puncheon for nine months of maturation before fining and bottling in early March.

#### FOOD PAIRING

Butterflied leg of lamb flavoured with garlic and rosemary charred on the barbecue

#### VINTAGE NOTES

The growing season commenced with reasonable winter rainfall. The continuation of La Nina saw an increase in spring rain before a relatively warm and dry start to summer. Ripening slowed as conditions cooled and allowed most varieties to move steadily. The resulting wines retained great freshness, intensity, elegance, and balance.
