We have refined and simplified our in-house grading - each with their own corresponding decals - making it easier to select a bat that fits your requirements.



**PLAYER Range** - crafted from Grade One English willow, our PLAYER range is our most popular series. Please expect these bats to have mild blemishing or knots on the bat. This does not affect performance in any way. Offering outstanding playability, this grade is a fantastic choice in the M&H range for players of all ability levels.



**PRO Range** - selected from the finest Grade One English willow, the PRO range features evenly spaced straight grains with a face that is free of blemishes. Each bat offers exceptional rebound and playing characteristics making our Pro range desirable for aspiring professional cricketers.



**SPECIAL EDITION (SE) Range** - these artisan bats are crafted using the finest professional grade English willow, usually reserved for our top-level professional players and selected for its rebound qualities. It is the pinnacle of our craftsmanship and will provide you with unrivalled playing characteristics.

C100 - CONCAVE PROFILE / TAPERED TOE



C200 - CONCAVE PROFILE / HYBRID TOE



**'F' Range** - bats that feature traditional full profiles with no concaving running from the spine to the outside edges on the back.

**'C' Range** - bats that feature concaving on the back making the bat feel lighter upon pickup, while maintaining a huge hitting area

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- **Tapered toe** - levelling out of the blades shape towards the toe, lightening its pickup and allowing for more wood to be left in the crucial hitting zone!
- **Hybrid toe** - features more wood allowing for an extended hitting zone down the length of the bat.
