

BLUE RIDGE INSTALL GUIDE

FOR: JEEP GLADIATOR ATTIC

Welcome! This installation isn't rocket science but it is kind of like karate - you can hurt yourself or break something if you don't pay attention. TOOLS YOU NEED:

Star Bit Screwdriver or Mini Ratchet



IMPORTANT: This attic has 6 attachment points: Four anchor straps will connect to the attic and two straps come sewn into the attic itself. Please orient the attic with the two sewn straps facing forward.









STEP #1

Remove the 4 trim screws as shown. Please note the location of the **front screws (A)** near speakers. **Back screws (B)** are still accessible even with roof in place.

STEP #2

Insert each screw through the hole in the 4 unattached anchor straps and tighten the trim screws back in place.

STEP #3

Unfold the attic and lay it on the rear seats, paracord side facing down. Orient it so that the two front middle straps which are sewn into the attic are facing toward the front of the vehicle.

STEP #4

Take the 2 anchor straps that you screwed in by the speakers and wrap them up over the roll bar of the Jeep. Attach them to the webbing at the front 2 corners of the attic.

STEP #5

Wrap the rear anchor straps up the C-Pillar of the Jeep as shown. Attach them to the webbing at the rear 2 corners of the attic.



FRONT OF VEHICLE

STEP #6

Take the 2 straps along the front edge of the attic and run them up and over the B-Pillar cross bar of the Jeep. Weave it back through the 3 bar slider attached to the attic. Contain any excess strap with the included Web Dominator elastic web keepers (see images below).





Adjust straps and paracord for desired tension. Load it up with jackets, rain gear, and other lightweight items. Enjoy keeping everything off the floor and easily accessible.
