#### **TOOLS YOU NEED: NONE**





#### **STEP #1**


Unfold the attic and lay it over the back seat with the tan paracord facing down.



### **STEP #2**

Take one of the front straps and run it OVER the grab handle.





#### **STEP #3**

Attach the G-Hook to the attic by weaving it into one of the flat loops that run down the front and rear of the attic.

NOTICE: Do NOT attach the hook back to the strap. It must be attached to the attic itself.

Repeat for other 3 straps.

#### **STEP #4**

Pull the tail end of the straps outward from the attic to achieve desired tension.



### **STEP #5**

Tighten the paracord by grasping the barrel lock with one hand and pulling the end with the other to achieve desired tension.



#### **STEP #6**

Brag to your friends about how organized you are!

NOTE: Please make sure not to overload the attic. We also recommend using it to store softer, lightweight items (like sleeping bags, jackets, coats, hats, etc).
