


Vinyl Cut Window Graphic

Important Pre-Installation Notes -

- 1. Do not install your sticker in extreme hot or cold temperatures.
- 2. When you receive your sticker, lay out on a flat surface and smooth across the surface. This will help the clear transfer tape adhere to the sticker.
- 3. During shipping it is not uncommon for air pockets or creases to develop beneath the transfer tape. This will not affect the sticker itself. Correct by laying on a flat surface and applying hand pressure smoothly across the surface to clear the air pockets.
- 4. When you lift the clear transfer tape off the backing paper, the sticker should also come away with the transfer tape. If any part of the sticker remains stuck to the backing paper, slowly lay it back down and firmly rub over the affected area until it lifts away correctly.
- 5. If any part of the backing paper tears and attaches itself to the adhesive side of your sticker: Use tweezers to remove the paper only (discard paper).
- 6. When you remove the clear transfer tape away from the <u>surface of the vehicle</u>, the sticker should remain stuck to the vehicle. If any part of the sticker remains stuck to the transfer tape, slowly lay it back down and firmly rub over the affected area until it remains stuck to the vehicle.

STICKER COMPILATION



APPLICATION TOOLS THAT MAY ASSIST

- 1. CLEANING CLOTH.
- 2. ALCOHOL RUB OR WARM SOAPY WATER.
- 3. FELT EDGE SQUEEGEE APPLICATOR OR RIGID CARD WITH THE EDGE WRAPPED IN A SOFT MATERIAL LIKE A SOCK (TO REDUCE ABRASIVENESS).





1. Clean & **DRY** surface with an alcohol rub or soapy water. Lay decal on a flat surface and smooth over the face area with your application tool. This will ensure a firm seal between transfer tape and vinyl.



2. Slowly separate the backing paper from transfer tape. NOTE - If any part of the decal remains stuck to the backing paper, lay the transfer tape back down and rub over that section of the decal to ensure firm contact then re-attempt lift.



3. Slowly position on desired surface, contacting the centre of the decal firstly then laying out toward edges.



4. Used a soft edge application tool like a felt squeegee or rigid card with something soft over the edge to reduce abrasiveness. Press firmly, rubbing toward the edges, removing air pockets.



5. Slowly Remove transfer tape in a diagonal direction. If any part of the decal remains stuck to transfer tape, lay it back down, and rub over that section to ensure contact with surface, then re-attempt lift.



6. Use a pin to poke holes in any air bubbles and press out the air.

Enjoy your new sticker.
