

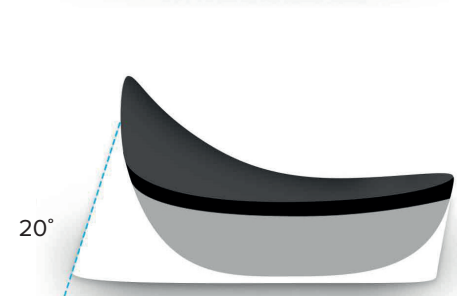
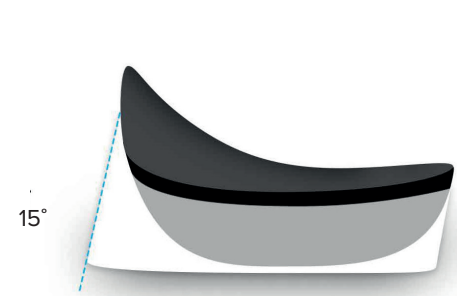
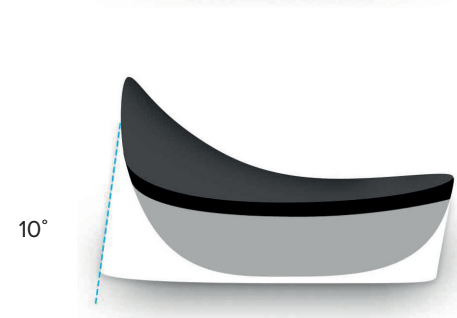
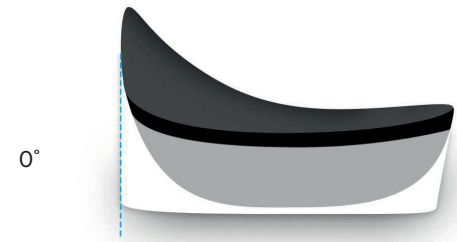
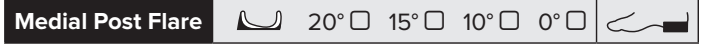
# Anti-Pronation Reaction & Posts - Rearfoot

## Medial Post Flare

A medial post flare is an outward bevel (flare) of an extrinsic rearfoot post in the medial direction. The purpose of a medial post flare is to increase the surface area of the plantar, medial surface of an extrinsic rearfoot post to increase subtalar joint pronation resistance.
