## Cutting Instructions:

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A - Toscana Picket Fence (White):
-(4) 4.5" X WOF strips. Subcut (12) 12.5" X 4.5" rectangles.

- (2) $9.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut (4) $18.5^{\prime \prime} \times 9.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
-(1) 10.5" X WOF strip. Subcut (2) 10.5 " X 10.5 " squares and (4) $8.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5$ " rectangles.
-(1) 8.5 " X WOF strip. Subcut (4) 8.5 " X 4.5 " rectangles and (4) 4.5" X 4.5 " squares.

Fabric B - Clusters Purple:

- (7) $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding.

Fabric C- Tossed Lilacs Lavender:
-(16) 4.5" X 4.5" squares.

## Fabric D- Clusters Green:

-(2) 9.25 " X $9.25^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (8) 9.5 " X 9.5 " squares.

## Fabric E- Small Blooms Purple:

- FIRST cut (1) 10.5 " X $10.5^{\prime \prime}$ square and (2) $9.25^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X}$
9.25" squares. From remaining fabric, cut (24) 4.5" X
3.5 " rectangles.


## Fabric F- Tonal Vines Lavender:

- (24) 4.5" X 3.5 " rectangles.


## Fabric G - Small Blooms White:

- (24) $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

Fabric H-Floating Small Blooms White:

- (24) $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

Fabric I - Packed Lilacs Purple:

- (2) 10.5 " $\times 10.5$ " squares.

Fabric J - Tonal Vines Green

- (1) $10.5 \times 10.5$ " square.

Fabric K - Packed Lilacs White:

- (2) 10.5 " X 10.5 " squares.

- H - (24) 4.5" X 3.5 " rectangles.


## Week 3 fabrics:

- A - (4) 4.5" X 4.5 " squares, (8) $8.5 \times 4.5$ " rectangles.
- C - (16) 4.5" X $4.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- D - (2) $9.25^{\prime \prime} \times 9.25^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- E - (2) 9.25" X 9.25" squares.


## Week 4 fabrics:

- A - (2) $10.5^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares, (4) $18.5^{\prime \prime} \times 9.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
-D - (8) 9.5" $\times 9.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- I - (2) 10.5 " $\times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares.


## Week 5 fabrics:

- B - (7) 2.5" X WOF strips (set aside for binding).

- E - (1) $10.5^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ square
- J-(1) 10.5" X $10.5^{\prime \prime}$ square.
- K - (2) $10.5^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ square.



## Make 1

General Instructions:
All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. RST= right sides together. Press seams as preferred.

1. Use E \& J squares. Cut each square diagonally from corner to corner (both sides) to create (4) triangles from each square. With RST, place GREEN on the bottom and PURPLE on the top as shown. Stitch right side as shown. Carefully open and press seams open. (Fig. 1). Make 4.

2. Use K squares. Cut each square once, diagonally from corner to corner. Finger press RST to mark center. Match center of K triangles to center seam of E/J triangles. Stitch and press. Trim completed blocks to 9.5 " X 9.5". (Fig. 2). Make 4.

3. Arrange as shown. Stitch and press. Finished block should measure $18.5^{\prime \prime} \times 18.5^{\prime \prime}$. (Fig. 3). Make $\mathbf{1}$.
