

Fort Worth Fabric Studio's Ultimate Picnic QUILT



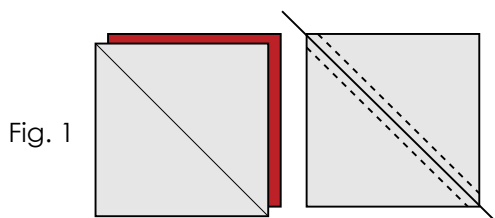
HST Star Block

General Instructions:

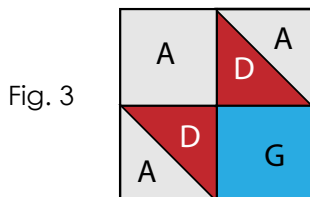
All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. RST= right sides together. Press seams as preferred.

Fabrics: A (4) 3" X 3" squares, (4) 4" X 4" squares & (4) 2" X 5.5" rectangles
 D (4) 4" X 4" squares
 G (4) 3" X 3" squares
 J (1) 2" X 2" square

1. Use (4) A and (4) D - 4" X 4" squares to create HST Blocks. On wrong side of A squares, draw a diagonal line corner to corner. Place A & D squares RST. Stitch 1/4" on either side of drawn line. Cut diagonally (corner to corner) on drawn line. (Fig. 1) You will have a total of 8 HST blocks when finished. **Trim blocks to 3" X 3" squares.** (Fig. 2) We suggest using a Bloc Loc Ruler.



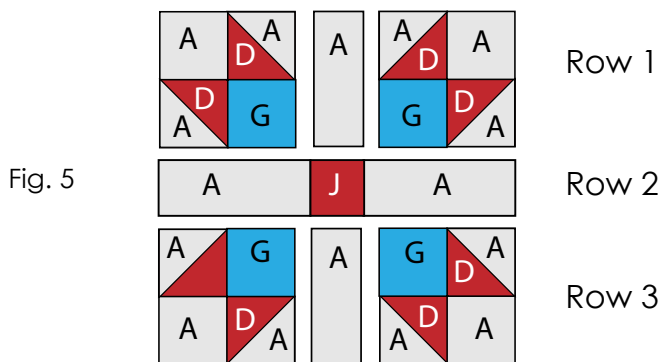
2. Use completed HST blocks from step 1, (4) A squares 3" X 3" and (4) G squares 3" X 3" to make 4 star block sections as shown. (Fig. 3) Blocks should finish at 5.5" X 5.5". Make 4.



3. Use (2) A rectangles 2" X 5.5" and J square to make one sashing strip. (Fig. 4)



4 Assemble in rows as shown. (Fig. 5) Block should measure 12" X 12" when finished. Make 1 block.



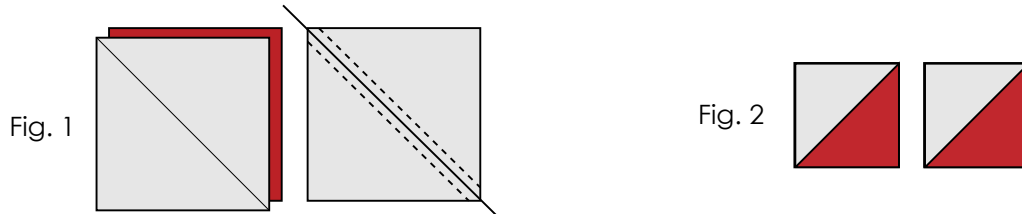
HST Pinwheel Block

General Instructions:

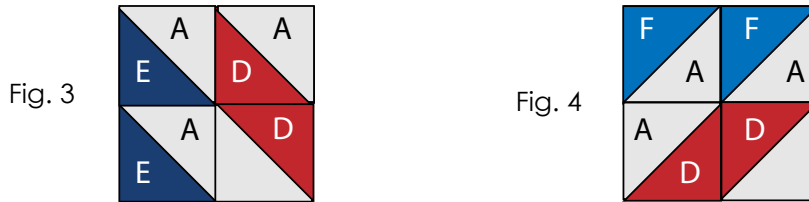
All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. RST= right sides together. Press seams as preferred.

- Fabrics:** A (8) 4" X 4" squares, (4) 2" X 5.5" rectangles
 D (4) 4" X 4" squares
 E (2) 4" X 4" squares
 F (2) 4" X 4" squares
 J (1) 2" X 2" square

1. Use all 4" X 4" squares to create HST Blocks. On wrong side of A squares, draw a diagonal line corner to corner. Pair all A squares with printed squares, RST. Stitch 1/4" on either side of drawn line. Cut diagonally (corner to corner) on drawn line. (Fig. 1) You will have a total of 8 A/D HST blocks, 4 A/E blocks, and 4 A/F blocks when finished. **Trim all blocks to 3" X 3" squares.** (Fig. 2) We suggest using a Bloc Loc Ruler.



2. Use completed HST blocks from step 1 to make block sections in Figure 3 & Figure 4. Stitch together. Blocks should finish at 5.5" X 5.5". Make 2 of each.



3. Use (2) A rectangles 2" X 5.5" and J square to make one sashing strip. (Fig. 5)



4 Assemble in rows as shown. (Fig. 6) Block should measure 12" X 12" when finished. Make 1 block.
