## Fabrics Used:



Place an A square and an I square right sides together. Mark a line from corner to corner. Stitch a $1 / 4 / 4$ from each side of the drawn line. With a rotary cutter and ruler, cut along your marked line. Press your half square triangles to the dark fabric. Make 4 half square triangles for each pinwheel. Trim half square triangles to $\mathbf{2} 58^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{x} \mathbf{5} \mathbf{5 8}^{\prime \prime}$


Sew your half square triangles into rows of two. Press. Then sew your rows together. Make 16 pinwheel blocks.

Read all instructions before starting. Seam allowance for this block is $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$

$43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$


Take a D square and two J squares. Place one J square on the top right corner. Place right sides together. Sew a diagonal line from corner to corner. Trim off excess $1 / 4$ " away from your sewn line. Place your other J square on the bottom left corner and repeat. Make 16.


Sew your units into rows of two. Press. Sew rows together. Press. Make 4. Should measure $43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$

Read all instructions before starting. Seam allowance for this block is $1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{HST}=$ half square triangle.


Place a C square and a K square right sides together. Mark a line from corner to corner. Stitch a $1 / 4 / 4$ from each side of the drawn line. With a rotary cutter and ruler, cut along your marked line. Press your half square triangles to the dark fabric. Trim half square triangles to 3" x 3" MAKE 14.


Place an F square and a C square right sides together. Mark a line from corner to corner. Stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from each side of the drawn line. With a rotary cutter and ruler, cut along your marked line. Press your half square triangles to the dark fabric. Trim half square triangles to 3" x 3" MAKE 2.


Take a rectangle $H$ and an $L$ square, place right sides together, lining up the top edges. Sew a diagonal line from corner to corner. Trim off excess $1 / 4$ " away from your sewn line. Make 4 left sides and 4 right sides.


Take your rectangle and G squares, place right sides together, lining up the bottom edges. Sew a diagonal line from corner to corner. Trim off excess $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from your sewn line. Make 4 left sides and 4 right sides.


Take the HST units and sew into a four-patch as pictured. Make 4.


Take the HST units and sew into a four-patch as pictured. Make 1.


Take the rectangle units and sew them into groups of two. Make 4.


Sew the blocks into rows of three. Press.


Sew your rows together. Press. Make one Springtime Star Block
Measures $15.5^{\prime \prime} \times 15.5^{\prime \prime}$

Read all instructions before starting. Seam allowance for this block is $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$


Sew pinwheel blocks together in rows of 4. Make 4 Rows. For two of the rows add a Butterfly block to the left and right side. Make two.


Sew an $M$ border strip to the left and right side of your center star. Press. Sew an N strip to the top and bottom press.


Sew pinwheel border to the top and bottom press.


Sew pinwheel border to the left and right side. Press.


Sew border strip O to the left and right sides. Press. Sew border strip P to the top and bottom. Press.


Sew your pieced border strip to the top and bottom. Press. Sew your pieced border strip to the left and right side. Press.


Sew a Q border strip to the left and right side. Press. Sew an R strip to the top and bottom. Press. Measures 37" x 37"
