

OVERVIEW

The Safariland Chest Rig, Model SAFCR (Figure 1), is a chest mounting system that pairs perfectly with most Safariland holsters. It is a great mounting option when belt mounts or thigh rigs are impractical, undesirable, or an outdoor adventure demands otherwise. The holster mounting Chest Plate (Figure 2) is engineered to balance performance, holster positioning and comfort while being worn. This thermoplastic elastomer plate's flexible arms optimize wearability while its reinforced interior section provides critical stability and functional strength during use. The combination of both braided and elastic webbing offers a wide sizing range while the quick release magnetic buckle, webbing management design and screwless attachment features enhance the product experience.

OUICK START

- 1. Inspect the Safariland holster being installed onto the chest rig. As long as the holster is equipped with the Safariland, standard three-hole, t-pattern mounting platform (Figure 3), it should be compatible with the SAFCR. This includes most Safariland holster models.
- 2. Remove the gun and then any mounting system, belt clip, or paddle from the hostler if present.

- 3. Secure the holster to the chest plate using three of the provided or previously existing #8 truss head machine screws and 1/8" hex drive or Allen wrench.
- 4. Release the magnetic quick release buckle (Figure 4). Insert your left arm into the loop created by the shoulder and chest harness. Position the shoulder pad on your left shoulder. Reconnect the magnetic quick release buckle by aligning the buckle ends and moving them close together (Figure 5). The magnetic buckle design will self-align and self-engage to secure the buckle closed when the two ends get in close enough proximity to each other.

5. Adjust each of the webbing harness's single bar slides to loosen or tighten as needed to snug-up the holster and chest plate to the body (Figure 6).

HARNESS FEATURES

The Safariland Chest Rig features three separate webbing harnesses, a Quick-Release Chest, Shoulder, and Chest Harness (Figure 7). All harnesses branch out from the backside's connection ring, wrap around the chest or shoulder and securely connect to the chest plate's extension arms with the

freely rotating swivel style connectors. Each harness features a single bar slide used for size adjustments and to help with webbing management. eliminating loose webbing ends (Figure 6). Sliding each harness single bar slides towards the backside ring will help fit the chest rig to smaller frame users. Sliding them towards the chest plate will increase the size for improved fit on larger chests. The Quick-Release Chest harness incorporates an innovative magnetic style buckle to easily put on or take off the rig as needed (Figures 4 & 5). The Quick- Release Chest harness also features an elastic webbing section to help maintain a solid, vet comfortable tension on the body while worn. Added stability and wear comfort is also provided by the Shoulder Harness's elastomer shoulder harness pad (Figure 8).

HARNESS FUNCTIONALITY AND FIT

Initially sizing and fitting the Safariland Chest Rig to your body size and wear location is easiest to do before mounting the holster on it. Slide the magnetic

quick release buckle apart (Figure 4). Feed your left arm through the open loop of the shoulder and chest harnesses. Slide the shoulder harness up your arm, until the shoulder pad rests on your left shoulder (Figure 8). Reconnect the magnetic buckle by aligning the buckle ends towards each other and moving them close together (Figure 5). The magnetic buckle design self-aligns and self-connects into the closed position. Adjust the webbing lengths using the bar slides on each strap to the fit most desirable. Disconnect the magnetic buckle once again and remove the Chest Rig to begin installing the holster.

HOLSTER COMPATIBILITY & ATTACHMENT

Most Safariland holster models are compatible with the Safariland Chest Rig. As long as the holster is equipped with the Safariland, standard threehole, t-pattern mounting platform (Figure 3), it should be compatible. Access the holster body assembly's integrated t-nut or slab nut posts by removing any existing mounting clip, platform, or paddle (Figure 9). Position the holster body assembly onto the Chest Plate ensuring alignment of threaded holster posts and Chest Plate hole and slots. Loosely secure the holster to the chest plate using the provided #8 truss head screws (Figure 10), Adjust the cant of the holster into the desired position and then finish tightening the three screws to secure the holster to and position on the chest plate.
