


4) Push the outer locking forks under the first set of loops (loop row 2). It is critical that the inner tines go under the loops and



5) Push the outer locking forks and inner tines under the next set of loops (loop row 3). Make sure barbs of the outer locking tabs emerge under the bottom of the loops. This will ensure a positive lock-up with the vest.




6) The MOLLE Accessory Mount is installed in the exact same manner.positive lock-up with the vest.






7) The MOLLE Holster Mount or the MOLLE Accessory Mount can be removed by squeezing the outer locking tabs together and pushing upward while pulling upward on the holster or other accessory.




8) When the outer locking tabs push through loop row 3, only one of the outer locking tabs needs to be squeezed inward while pulling the holster upward to pull through loop row 2.

#### **INSTALLING THE MOLLE RECEIVER PLATE WITH GUARD**

1) The MOLLE Receiver Plate with Guard can be installed on any platform with a matching hole pattern, such as a Tactical Leg Shroud or Belt Loop Mount (UBL). The MOLLE Receiver Plate utilizes 3 T-nuts that need to be installed in order to fasten it to the desired mounting platform. The T-Nuts need to be installed from the front side with the barbs of the T-nut inserting into the matching hole patterns on the MOLLE Receiver Plate. The diagrams below indicate the T-nut installation locations. The non-serrated screws are then installed from the opposite side of the mounting platform and tightened.




#### INSTALLING THE STANDARD MOLLE RECEIVER PLATE


1) The Standard MOLLE Receiver Plate can be mounted to any platform with a matching hole pattern, such as a MOLLE Adaptor Plate, however, it is recommended that it be mounted to the MOLLE Accessory Mount. The MOLLE Accessory Mount provides a much more secure and versatile mounting platform than most other adaptor plates. The MOLLE Accessory Mount also has the capability of allowing several other accessories to be mounted to it. The vertical 1-1/2", 2-hole pattern matches the mounting screw locations of many Safariland accessories such as Magazine Cases, Cuff-Cases, and Flashlight Cases. This allows for the quick arrangement and/or rearrangement of equipment on the MOLLE Vest with minimal effort.

2) The MOLLE Accessory Mount and the Standard MOLLE Receiver Plate have a locking spline ring that will allow for multiple orientation angles.




- 3) Insert a T-nut into the preferred spline ring hole pattern on the MOLLE Receiver Plate.
- 4) Alian the spline ring on the MOLLE Accessory Mount with the desired spline ring on the Standard MOLLE Receiver Plate.



5) The spline allows the Standard MOLLE Receiver Plate to be mounted at 15° angle increments. Before tightening down the mounting screw, be sure you have the desired mounting angle correctly aligned. After the desire angle orientation is discovered, press the splines of both components together and tighten the screw. Note: Do not use the serrated screws for this installation.

The completed assembly can now be installed onto the MOLLE straps to accept equipment mounted on the accessory mount or the firearm mounted on the holster mount.



# ARNING





#### LOCKING THE MOLLE HOLSTER MOUNT INTO THE MOLLE RECEIVER PLATE (STANDARD OR WITH GUARD)


1) With the desired holster already installed on the MOLLE Holster Mount, align the outer locking tabs of the MOLLE Holster Mount with the vertical channels on the MOLLE Receiver Plate. Note: MOLLE Holster Mount shown without holster for clarity.



2) Slide the Holster with the MOLLE Holster Mount and the MOLLE Receiver Plate together until the outer locking tabs "click" into the locked position.



3) To remove the MOLLE Holster Mount from the MOLLE Receiver Plate, simply squeeze the outer locking tabs and pull the Holster with the MOLLE Holster Mount away.



#### **Operating Instructions**

## SETTING UP AND INSTALLING THE MOLLE HOLSTER MOUNT

1) Choose the orientation that is desired for your holster. The MOLLE Holster Mount is ambidextrous and can be mounted vertically or at 45°. Use the #8 Serrated Screws. There are 2 lengths of #8 serrated screws, 3/8" and 1/2". Choose the length that will provide the best securement without protruding through the inside of the holster. Because the mounting screws are serrated and cannot be easily removed once tightened, it is important to decide on the holster orientation before tightening the screws. The diagrams below show the 2 different mounting orientations for both right and left hand arrangements. Note: Only the 2 upper screws are used for the 45° position.



- 2) The MOLLE Holster Mount will occupy a space on the MOLLE Vest 2 columns wide by 3 rows high. The desired mounting location on the MOLLE Vest will need to be cleared of other equipment before a successful installation.
- 3) Align the outer locking forks with loop column 1 and 2 just above loop row 2 as shown in the diagram below. Note: MOLLE Holster Mount shown without holster for clarity.
