

21055 Honda CB750 Hornet Radiator Cheeks 2023> Fitting Instructions

Kit Includes: 21055A Hornet Radiator Cheek (LHS) **X1 X1** 21055B Hornet Radiator Cheek (RHS) Carbon Steel Bracket (LHS) 3. **X1** CFK21055A 4. The installation process is replicated on both sides. This consists of the relevant panel and fixing bracket, together with an equal share of the supplied fixings. Please note: LHS denotes the left-hand side from the rider's point of view and likewise RHS denotes the right-hand side.

Assembly Instructions

- Begin by placing the foam pad strip (Item 11) on the LHS bracket (Item 3) in the positio marked in 'FIG. 3'. Please ensure the foam pad is lightly placed on the bracket in case it needs to be repositioned or trimmed.
- Continue by removing the two OEM fixings in the marked areas shown in 'FIG. 4' from the LHS of the motorcycle. Take the LHS bracket (Item 3), together with 1 x M5x16mm Bolt (Item 5), and thread the bolt into the marked area '1' shown in 'FIG. 4'. Tighten the bolt so that the bracket is parallel with the face of the radiator cheek on the motorcycle. Please do not overtighten the bolt as you may wish to adjust this angle slightly to improve the fitment of the Pyramid Radiator Cheek.
- Take the LHS Radiator Cheek (Item 1), along with 1 x M6x30mm bolt (Item 6) and 1 x black nylon spacer (Item 10). Place the spacer on the underside of the lower mounting point of the panel and thread the M6 bolt through and into the area marked '2' shown in 'FIG. 3'. Please do not tighten at this stage.
- Proceed by taking 1 x M6x12mm bolt (Item 7) and 1 x M6 nut (Item 8) and placing through the upper mounting hole of the panel to secure the bracket. Please check the alignment of the Radiator Cheek and make any adjustments by altering the angle of the bracket. Please check the support provided by the foam pad by gently pressing in that area. Make any necessary adjustments. Once you are happy with the fitment, firmly press the foam pad and tighten all fixings to sufficient resistance.
- Finally, place 2 x bolt end caps (Item 9) over the bolt heads. Repeat this step for the RHS of the motorcycle.

Please Note:
We advise that all fixings are checked periodically.









Please note: 2 x Item 9 shown in 'FIG. 2' is not required with colour options 'Pearl Glare White' or 'Goldfinch Yellow' but may be used if desired.







Foam pad strip placed up to the bend in the supporting bracket.
Replacement or trimming may be required.

Alignment of bracket to be parallel in relation to the motorcycle. This angle may need to be altered upon fitment of the Radiator Cheek.

'FIG. 4' illustrates how to alter the angle of the bracket without having to remove the Radiator Cheek. Please ensure the bolt in the lower mounting position has been sufficiently loosened before attempting to rotate the Radiator Cheek.

Decal Application Instructions

- Be sure to work indoors on a clean surface.
- Thoroughly clean the product you are applying the decals to. Making sure there is no dust or dirt present is important for getting the best bond between the adhesive and product.
- You will need a water solution mixed with 4-6 drops of washing up liquid or soap, along with either a squeegee or credit card.
- With a soft sponge/cloth, apply the water solution to the designated area of the product. It is important to cover the whole area you plan to apply the decal to, this makes it easier to position on the product.
- Remove the backing paper and be sure to avoid the adhesive side of the Decals. The more contact you make with the adhesive, the less effective it will be after application.
- Lay the decal onto the product and move into position. The water allows enough movement for optimum placement on the product.
- Once you are happy with the placement of the decal, use the squeegee or credit card to squeeze out any water and air from beneath the decal. Work from the center towards the edges. Once all the water is squeezed out, the adhesive will kick in.
- Leave the decal to cure for at least 10 minutes.
- Note: Clear Application Tape Removal (if included):

If your decal kit comes with application tape installed, follow all the previous steps, let the decal cure for at least 10 minutes and then carefully peel off the application tape at a 45-degree angle, it is important to make sure the decal remains on the surface while peeling off the application tape.
